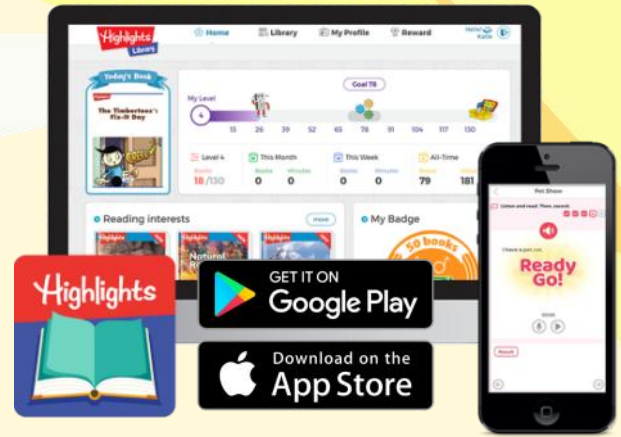

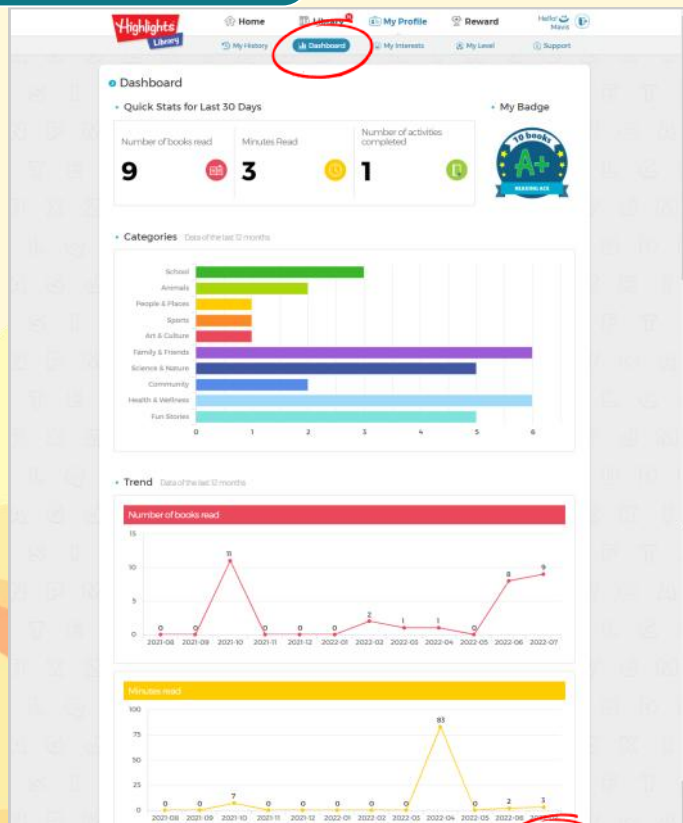

Students can bookmark by double-clicking and reach the page by the button.

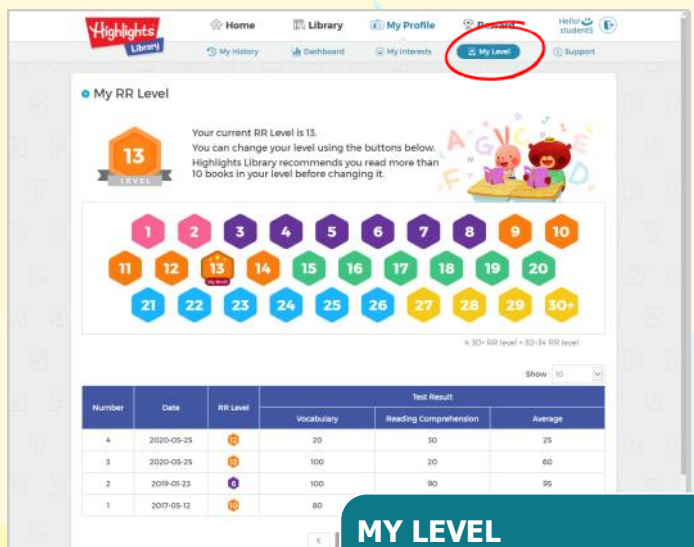
READING HISTORY
