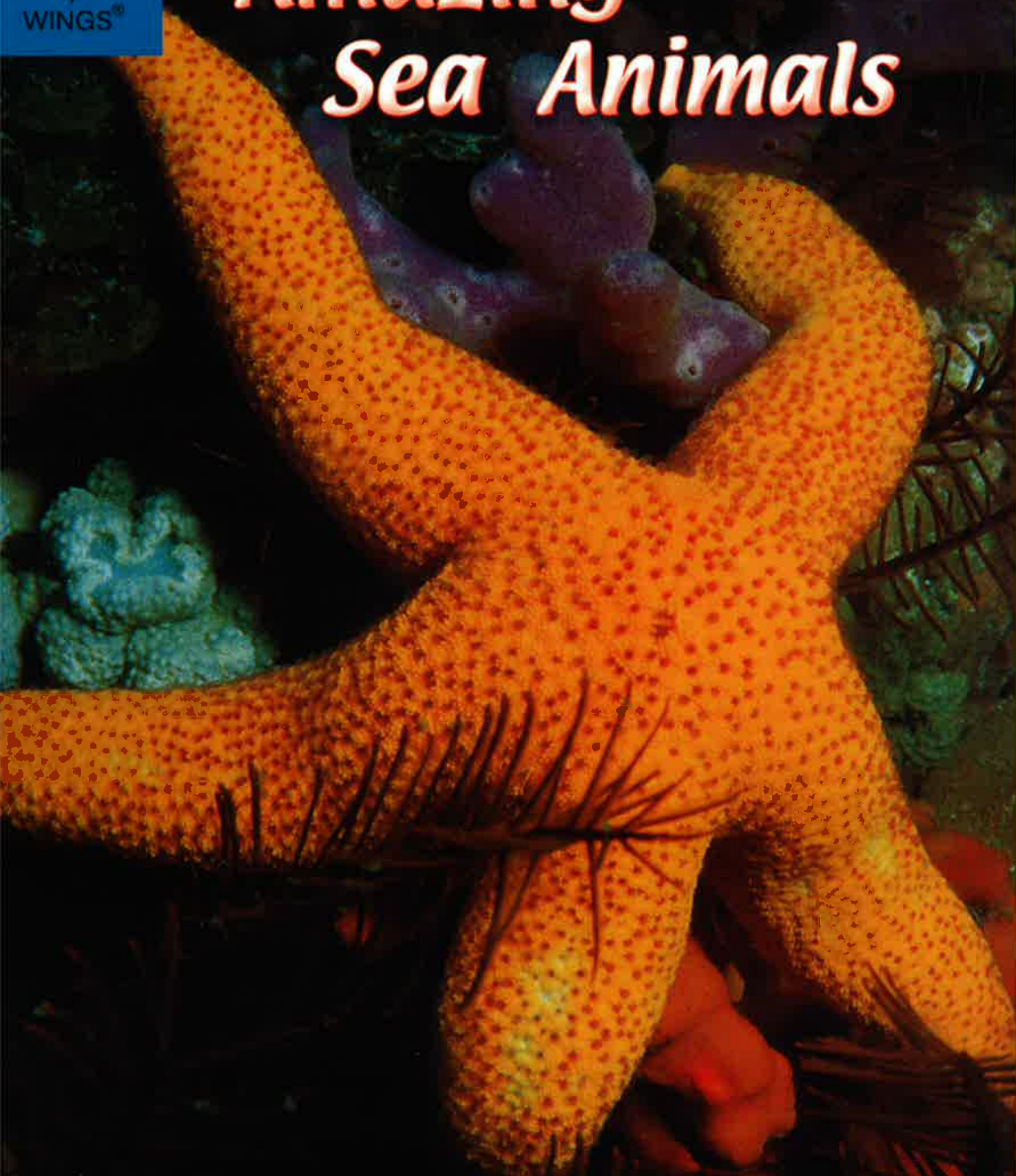




Amazing Sea Animals

Look at these animals. They have a long body with a head at the front.

Their bodies have two sides that look the same. They have a left side and a right side.



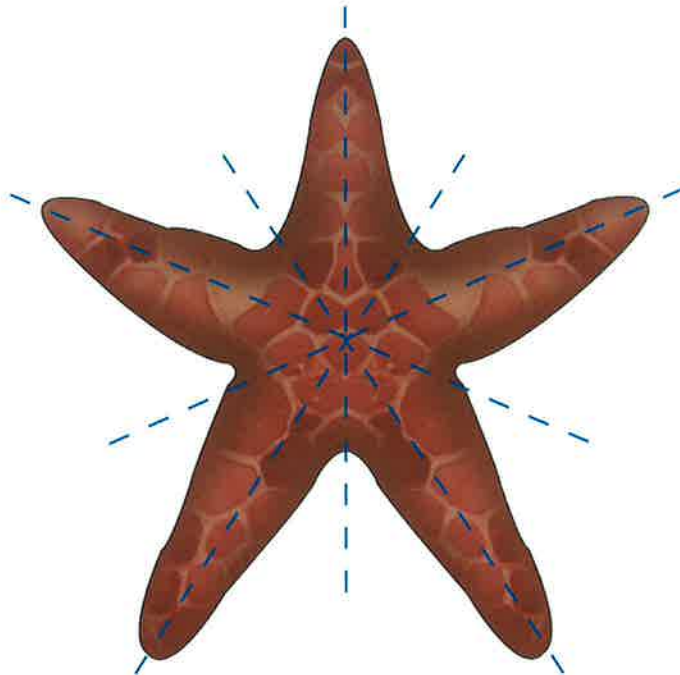
Some of the animals have legs – two, four or six legs.

Now look at these animals. They have a round body and no head.

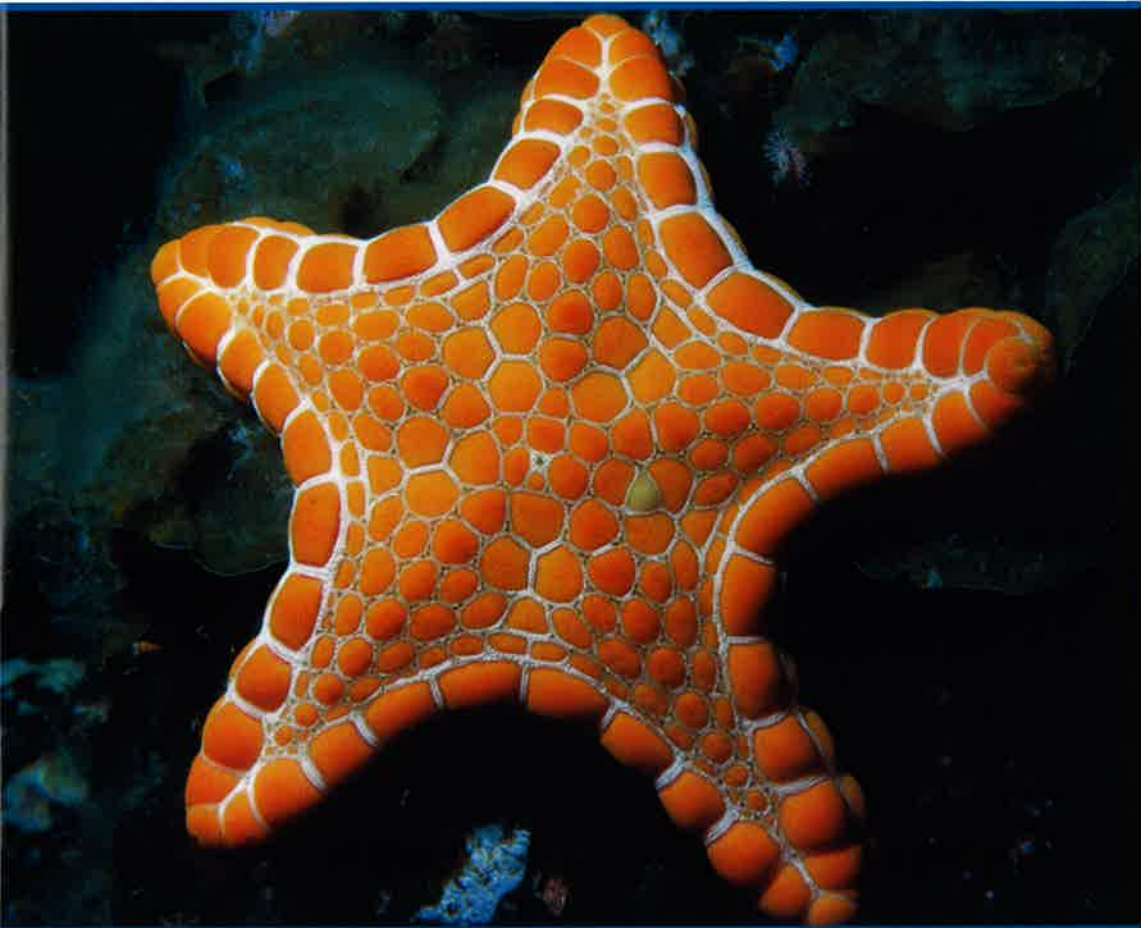


Their bodies have more than two sides that look the same.



For teachers' inspection ONLY

They are called 'starfish' but they are not really fish. Sometimes they are called 'sea stars'. There are about 2,000 kinds of starfish. They all live in the sea.

Starfish have arms. These arms are called 'rays'. Many starfish have five rays. Some have more. Some have very small rays.



For teachers' inspection ONLY

The largest known starfish has rays that are 67 centimetres (26½ inches) long. That is as long as a tall person's arm.
