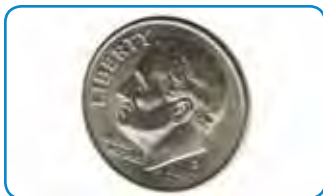

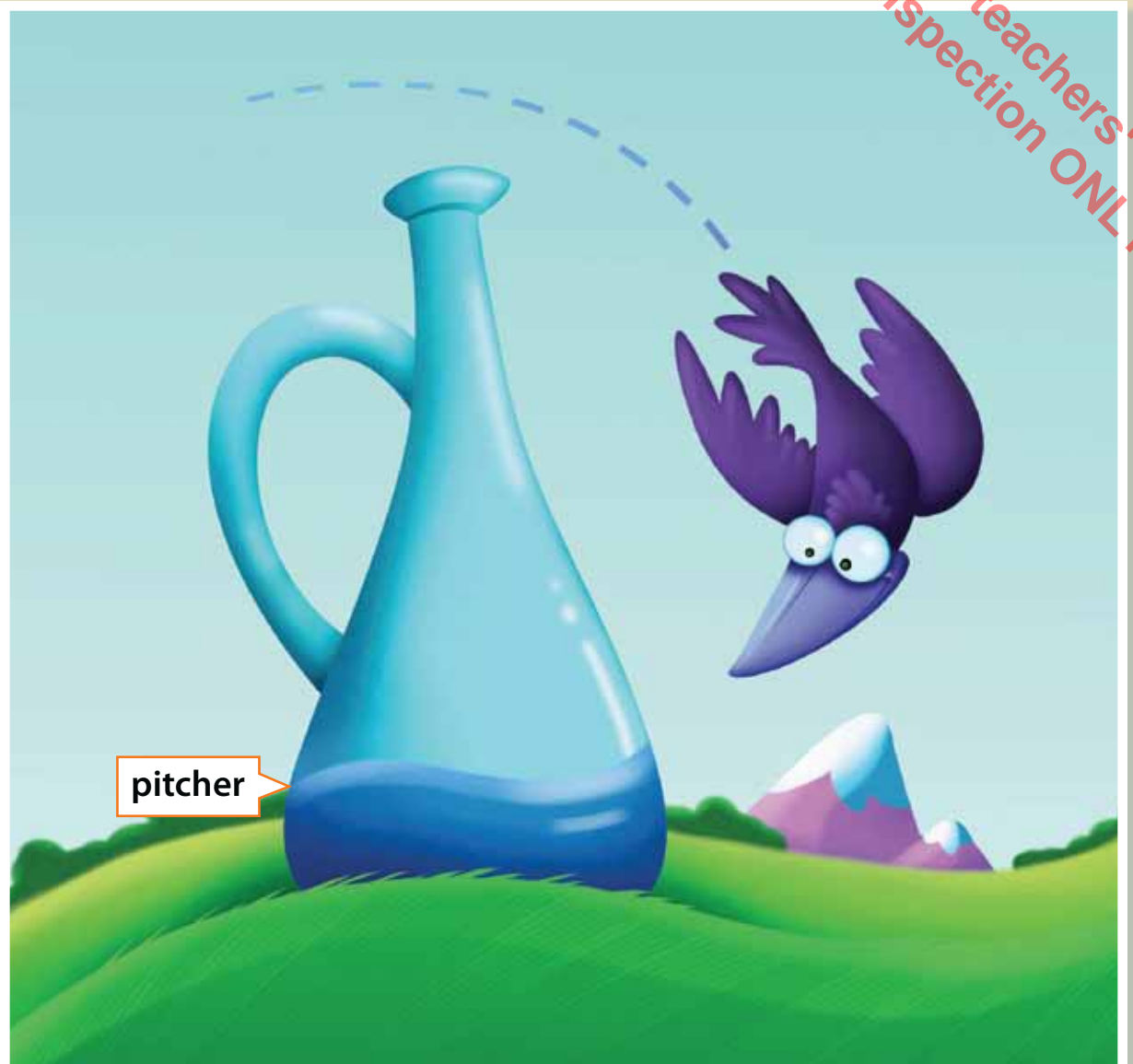
Crow and the Pitcher

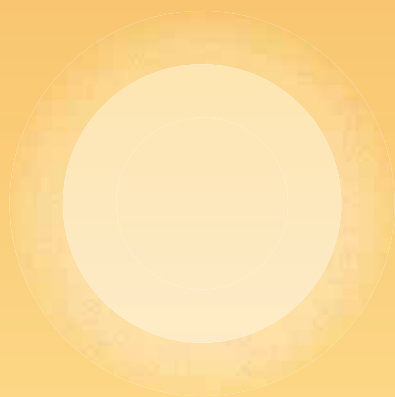


- 2 It has a wide stem that traps water inside.
