
## Introduction


Paul Cézanne is a French artist from the late 19<sup>th</sup> century. He has been called the father of modern art. Cézanne used geometric form and color in a new way.

He showed us that color could change the form of an object.

Modern art is art from the 1860s–1970s. It focused on new ideas and ways of seeing things.








Today, we think of Cézanne as a genius. However, during his life, most people rejected his ideas about art. It was only after his death that he became well known.

Do you recognize da Vinci's Mona Lisa (1503-1506)? Da Vinci was another well-known artist.









## **Early Life**

Paul Cézanne was born in 1839 in Aix, France. His family was quite rich. His father, who was a banker, was very conservative. Cézanne was interested in art from an early age. However, his father did not like this. He wanted Cézanne to become a lawyer.




Aix is a city in southern France.









Because of this, Cézanne could not formally study art. He studied law at school, and even started to work at his father's bank.







But during all this, he did not give up on his art.

Cézanne went to nearby art classes

at night. He taught himself painting techniques.

One painting technique is "wet on wet." This is putting more wet paint over wet paint.
