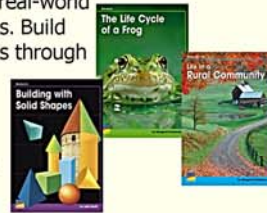

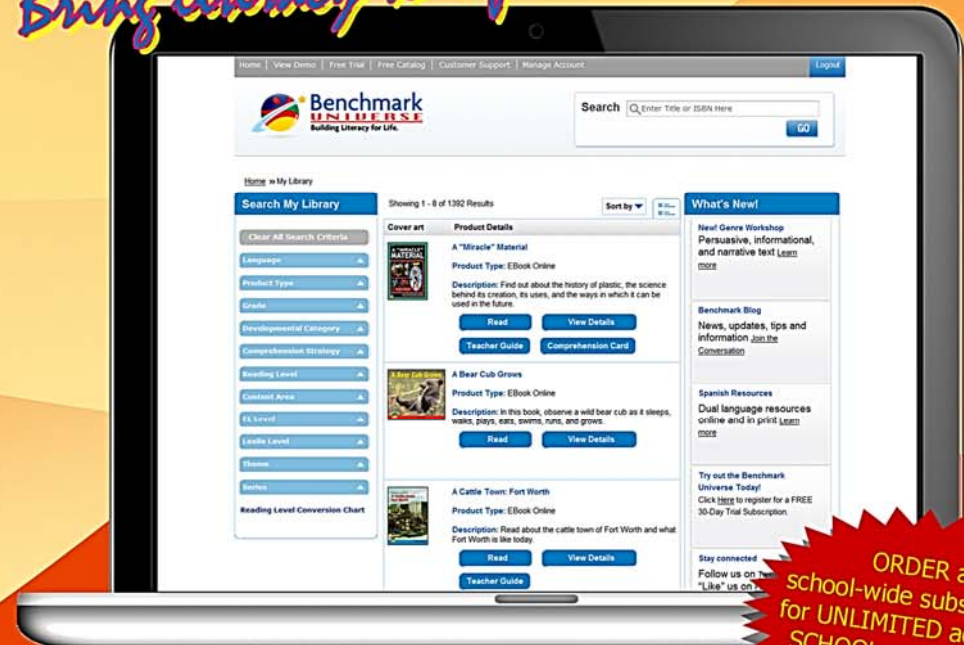

What Is the Water Cycle?

The **water cycle** is a pattern in nature. The water cycle is happening all the time. Earth has huge amounts of water. This water is always moving.

The water cycle moves Earth's water to different places. Water changes form as it moves.

One part of the water cycle is **evaporation**. Evaporation happens when the sun warms **liquid** water. Then the water changes form. The liquid water becomes **gas**. This gas is
