Key Teaching Points

- Discuss the difference between a fiction and non-fiction book.
- Make connections between the photographs, vignettes and written text.
- Talk about why the steps in a procedure must be ordered sequentially.

Key Questions

- Why couldn't Meg make the slide show without help from Dad?
(*Inferential*)
- Why is it important to look at all the photos before choosing some for the slide show? (*Inferential*)

Word Study

- Change the onsets to make new words: *call, name, pick, plug, slide*.
- Revisit the sounds *-ch, -st, -ck, -er*. Find words in the book with these sounds.
