Oh well, at least they tried.

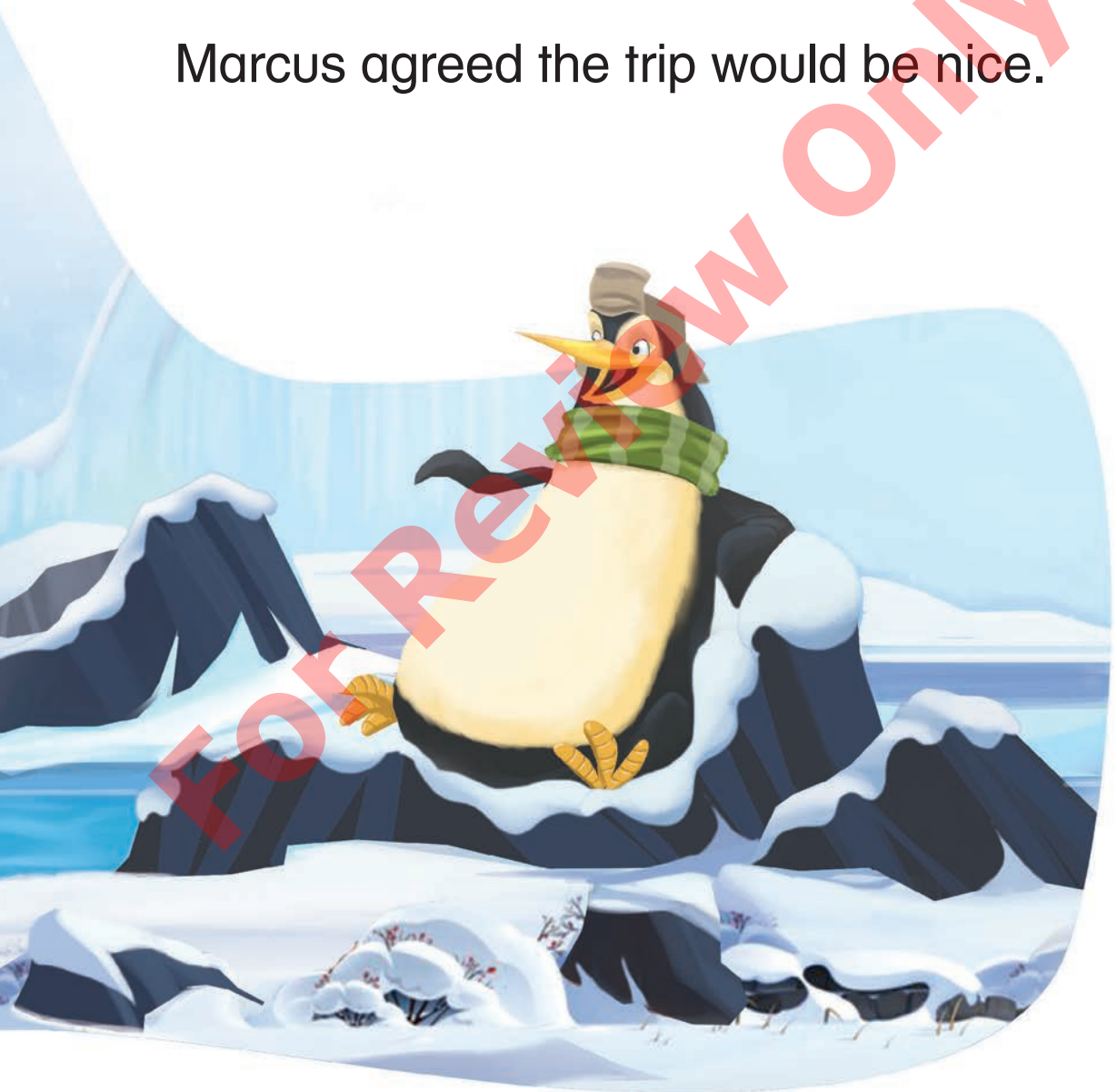






Linda said, "I have an idea!
