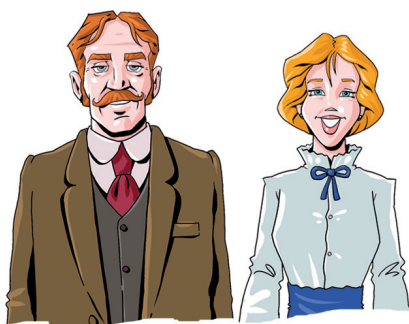
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THE CHARACTERS

... is the father of Wendy, John, and Michael and the husband of Mrs Darling. Mr Darling is a strict man. However, he loves his children and he only wants what is best for them.

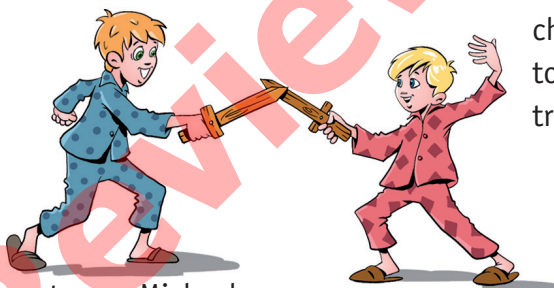


MRS DARLING

... is the middle Darling child. He enjoys playing games and having adventures. He is quite a brave boy. He loves his brother and sister, but he sometimes teases Michael.



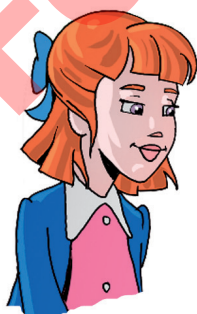
MICHAEL

... works for Captain Hook. He is not very clever. He is very afraid of his captain so he always does what Hook tells him

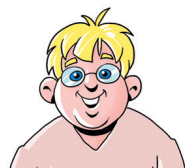
to do. Smee is not really a bad man.

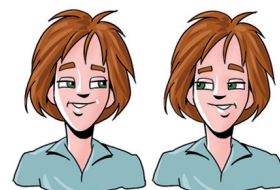

Narrator:

The Darlings lived in London. There was Mr and Mrs Darling. There were the three Darling children. And of course, we mustn't forget the children's nurse, Nana. They were the happiest family in London – until Peter Pan came.

Wendy:

I think Peter came into the nursery again last night Mother.

Mrs Darling:

Peter? Who is Peter?

John:

He is a little boy, just like me. But he is not from London. He is from the Neverland!

Michael:

He takes us there in our dreams!

Mrs Darling:

Don't be silly, children. No one can come into the house without knocking.

Wendy:

I think he comes in through the window.

John:

Yes! Peter can fly!

Mrs Darling:

That's enough now, children. Nana, put the children to bed.



- Narrator:** But Mrs Darling saw Peter Pan, too. One night she had sat down to sew a shirt for Michael. The room was warm and she quickly fell asleep. She dreamt that a boy called Peter was playing with the children in the magical Neverland. As she slept, the window blew open and Peter flew through it.
- Mrs Darling:** Aaargh! Nana!
- Narrator:** Peter tried to fly back out of the window, but as he tried to escape Nana snapped at him and pulled off his shadow. Mrs Darling didn't want anyone to know that she had seen Peter, so she hid his shadow in her chair. A few days later, Mr and Mrs Darling were going out for the evening with some friends.
- Mr Darling:** Now, be good children, and go to sleep quickly.
- Mrs Darling:** That's right, dears. Be good for Nana.
- Mr Darling:** Oh, Mary look at this! There are hairs on my trousers. Nana! You will sleep in the garden tonight.
- Mrs Darling:** I think Nana should stay here with the children, George.
- Mr Darling:** There is nothing to be afraid of. Nana can sleep in the garden and the children will be quite safe.
- Mrs Darling:** Oh, George, I hope you are right! Good night, children! Sweet dreams!

- Wendy:** Peter! Are you Peter Pan?
- Peter:** Yes. What is your name?
- Wendy:** Wendy Darling. Why are you crying?
- Peter:** I can't get my shadow to stick on! And anyway, I wasn't crying!
- Wendy:** I'll sew your shadow back on for you. There!
- Peter:** Oh! How clever I am! And you did a little, too.
- Wendy:** How old are you?
- Peter:** I don't know. But I am quite young. I ran away the day I was born. I didn't want to grow up, you see. So I went to live with the fairies.
- Wendy:** Oh! Is that a real fairy?
- Peter:** Yes, we live in the Neverland with the Lost Boys. They are boys who were lost when they were babies and their parents never found them, so they don't have mothers.
