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Reading This Book with Children

You can use this book to support literacy and social and emotional development.

1. Read the title of the book and talk about the picture on the cover. Ask: *What do you think this book will be about?*
2. Look at each page in the book. Talk about the pictures and ask children to point to words they know.
3. Read the book aloud and invite children to participate by reading the picture word in each sentence. Point to the words as you say them.
4. Enjoy reading the book several more times so children can begin to repeat the pattern and read independently.
5. Point out and discuss the examples of social and emotional development in the book.
