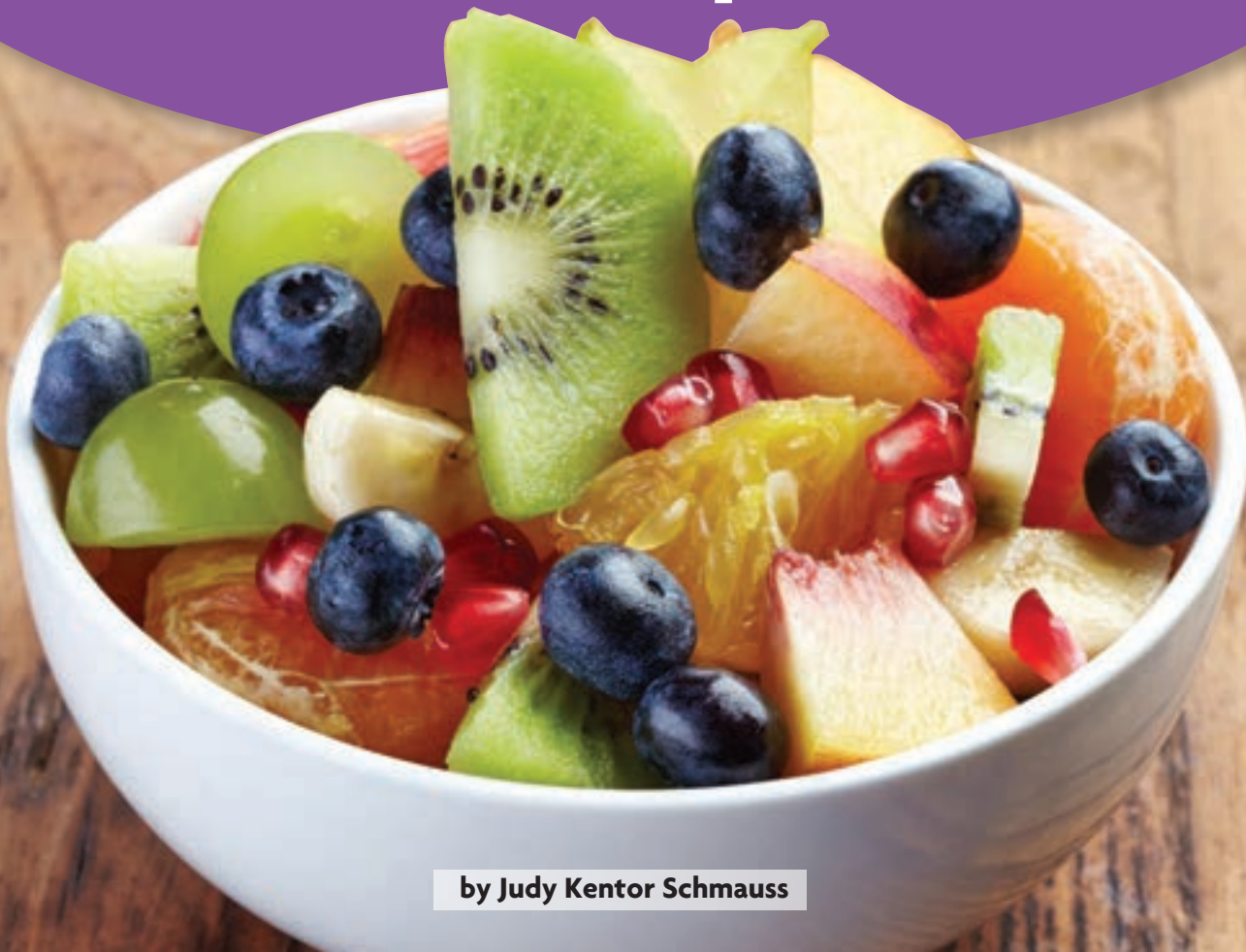




Fruit Surprise

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Reading This Book with Children

You can use this book to support literacy and creative expression.

1. Read the title of the book and talk about the picture on the cover. Ask: *What do you think this book will be about?*
2. Preview the picture words in the book. Say each word while you point to the picture.
3. Read the book aloud and invite children to participate by reading the picture word in **each** sentence. Point to the words as you say them.
4. Enjoy reading the book several more times so children can begin to repeat the pattern and read independently.
5. Point out and discuss the examples of creative expression in the book.
