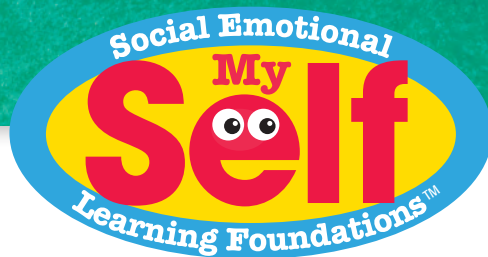

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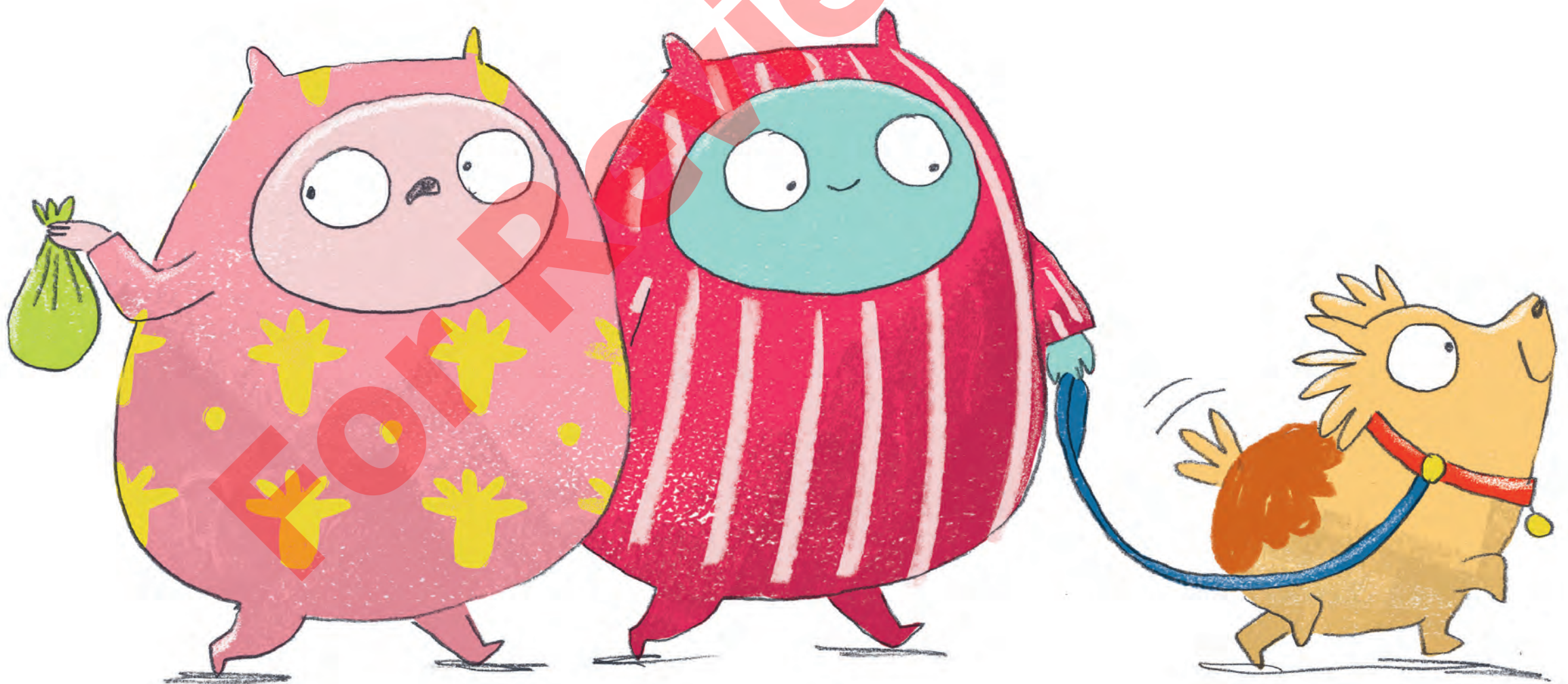
How to Read This Book with Children

- 1** Read aloud the title. Identify what it means to take care of something, such as a pet.
- 2** Read aloud the book with children.
- 3** Talk about ways children can work together to complete tasks at school and at home.
- 4** Ask children to describe what the twins learn about working together.
- 5** After reading, use the Real-World Wrap-Up prompts to discuss the photograph.
- 6** Guide children to identify times when they worked together to solve problems.

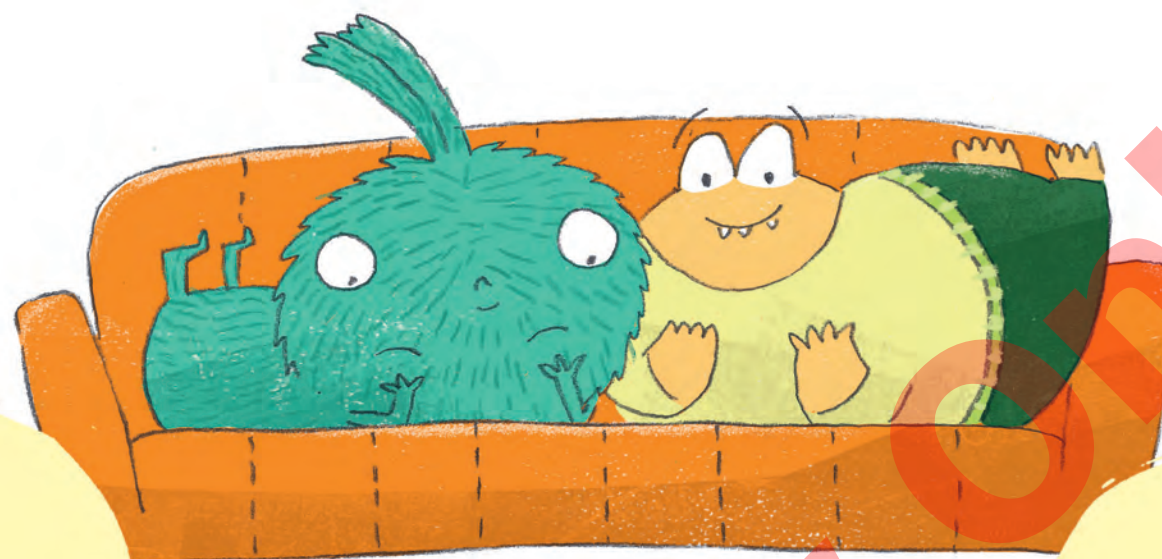
