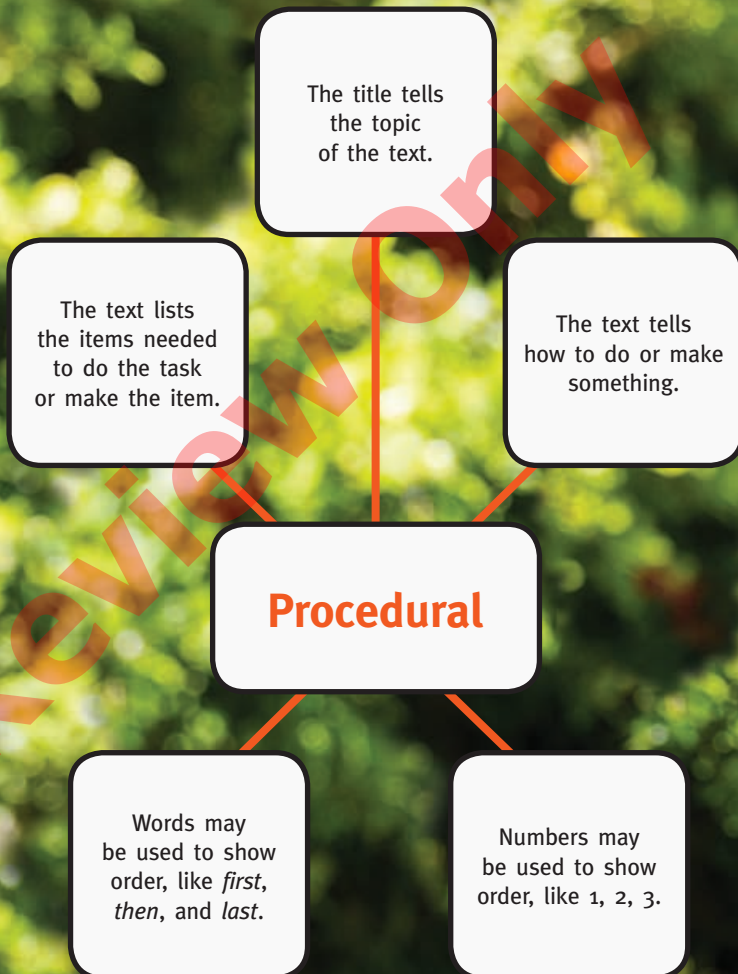


How to Help Others
