A Custodian's Tools

A device that uses suction to clean soft surfaces such as carpets.

mop

A tool for cleaning made of a bundle of cloth, yarn, or a sponge fastened to a handle.

broken

Having lost the ability to function because of damage, wear, or strain.



fingerprints
