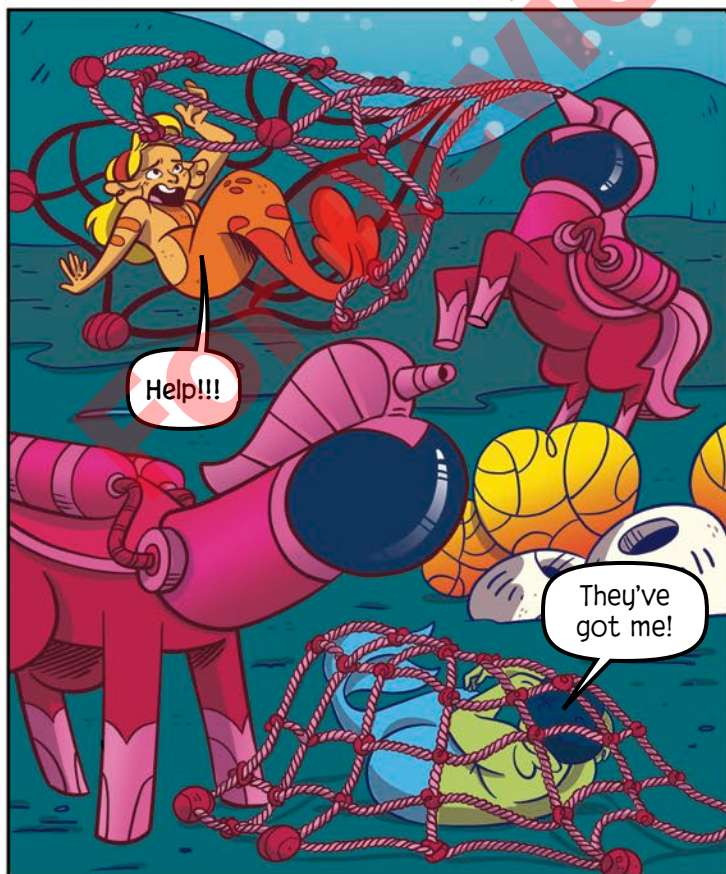
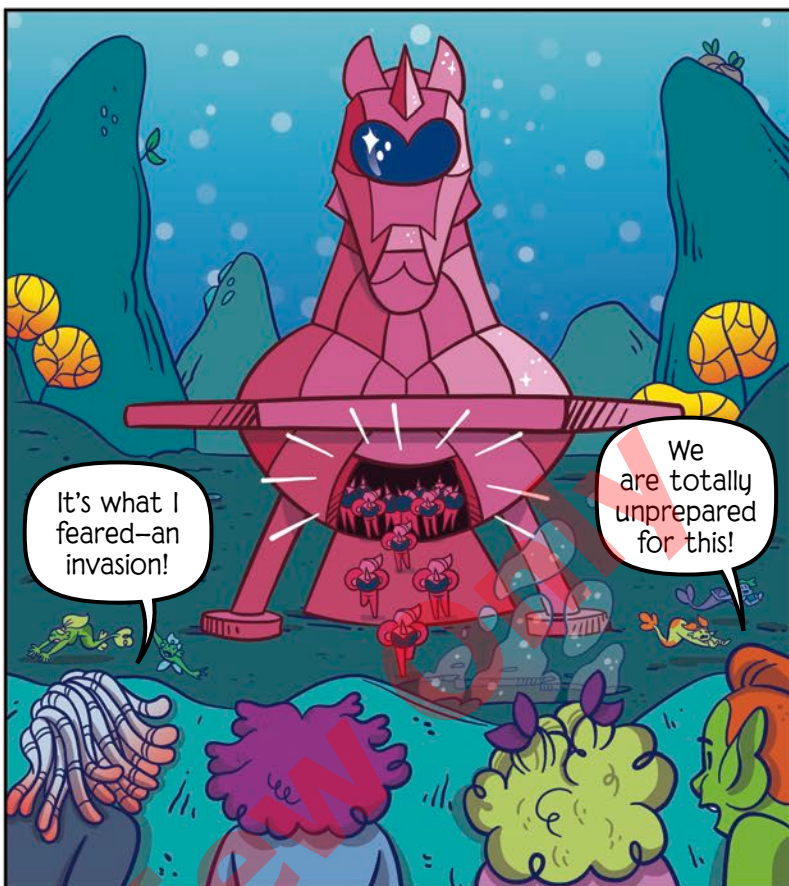












ALL ABOUT THE ORIGINAL STORY!

The War of the Worlds was written by science fiction author H.G. Wells. It first came out one chapter at a time in what was then called a serialized story. It was published in magazines in the United Kingdom and United States in 1897. The story was printed as a full novel in 1898.

In the novel, Martians are plotting an attack on Earth because the resources on their planet are dwindling. An unnamed narrator visits an astronomer friend who shows him through a telescope explosions on Mars's surface. He predicts that there is life on Mars!

Months later, a strange cylinder lands in the British countryside, and the narrator sees Martians come out of it! They can't survive in Earth's atmosphere, so they return to the cylinder. Humans try to make peace, but the Martians fire on them. The British army arrives and a giant battle between Martians and Earthlings begins.

The narrator escapes but then sees giant three-legged Martian fighting machines that have wiped out Earth's forces. The narrator flees to London, but the Martians invade. Humans have lost! They retreat from the city. Martians have taken control of the planet, and humans are on the run. Months after he leaves the city, the narrator finally makes his way back to London. He finds it abandoned and discovers that all the Martians have died. It turns out their bodies could not handle the germs that humans were used to. The narrator and the rest of humanity tries to go back to life as it once was by rebuilding society as best they can.
