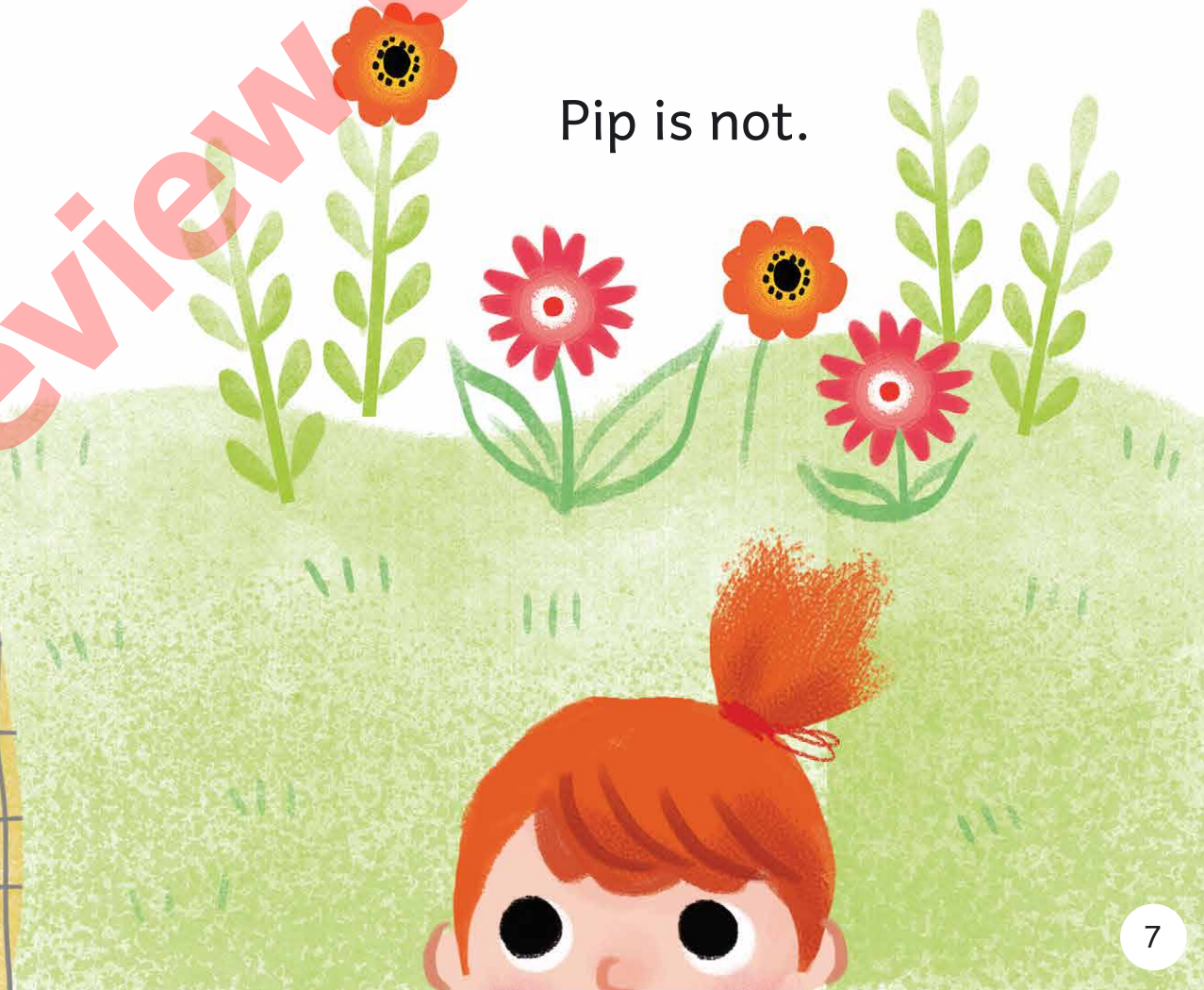
*Plant carrot or sunflower seeds of your own.*
