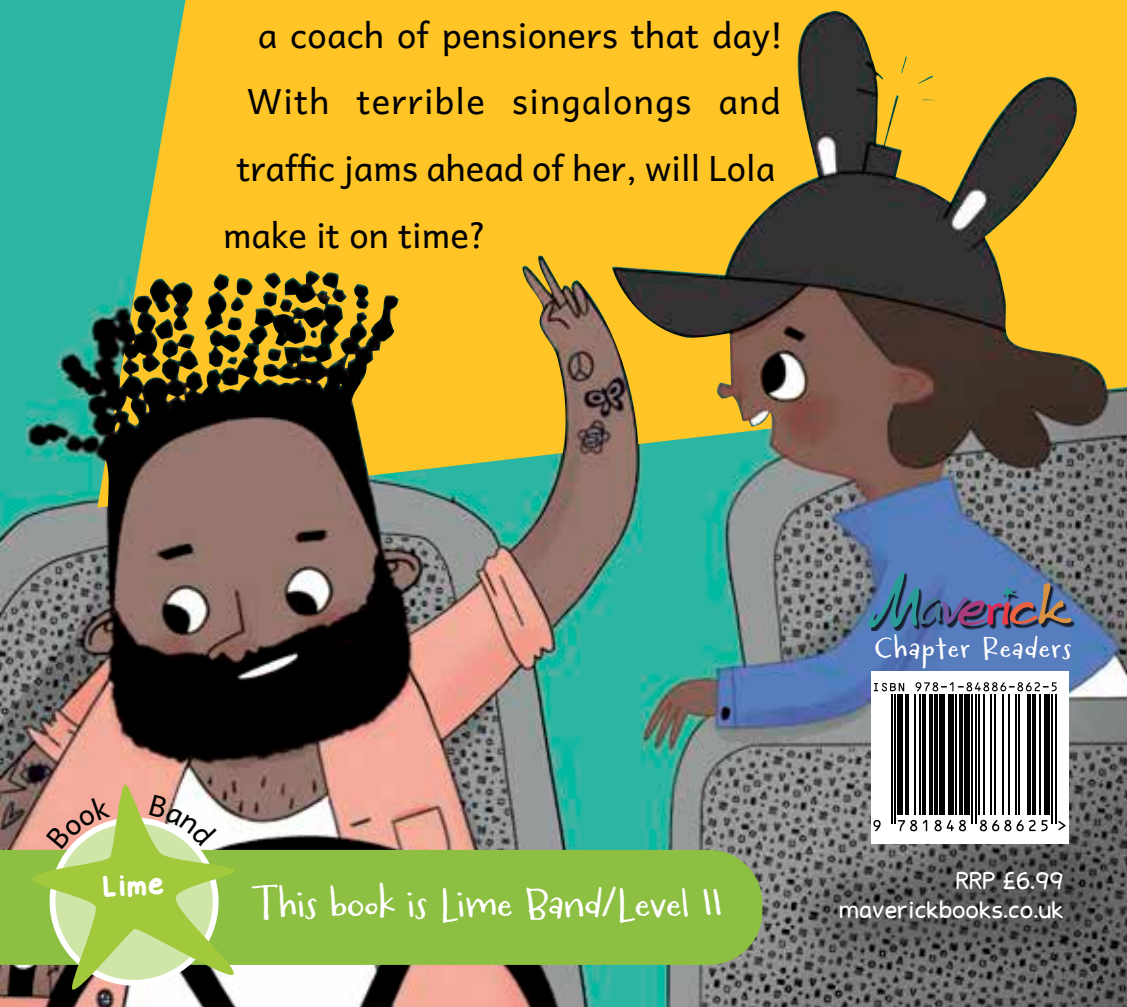


Rock Star Road Trip
