Jill and Ahmed are in class. The teacher, Mr Robinson, is asking the children to write a story about an adventure. They can write the story with a friend.



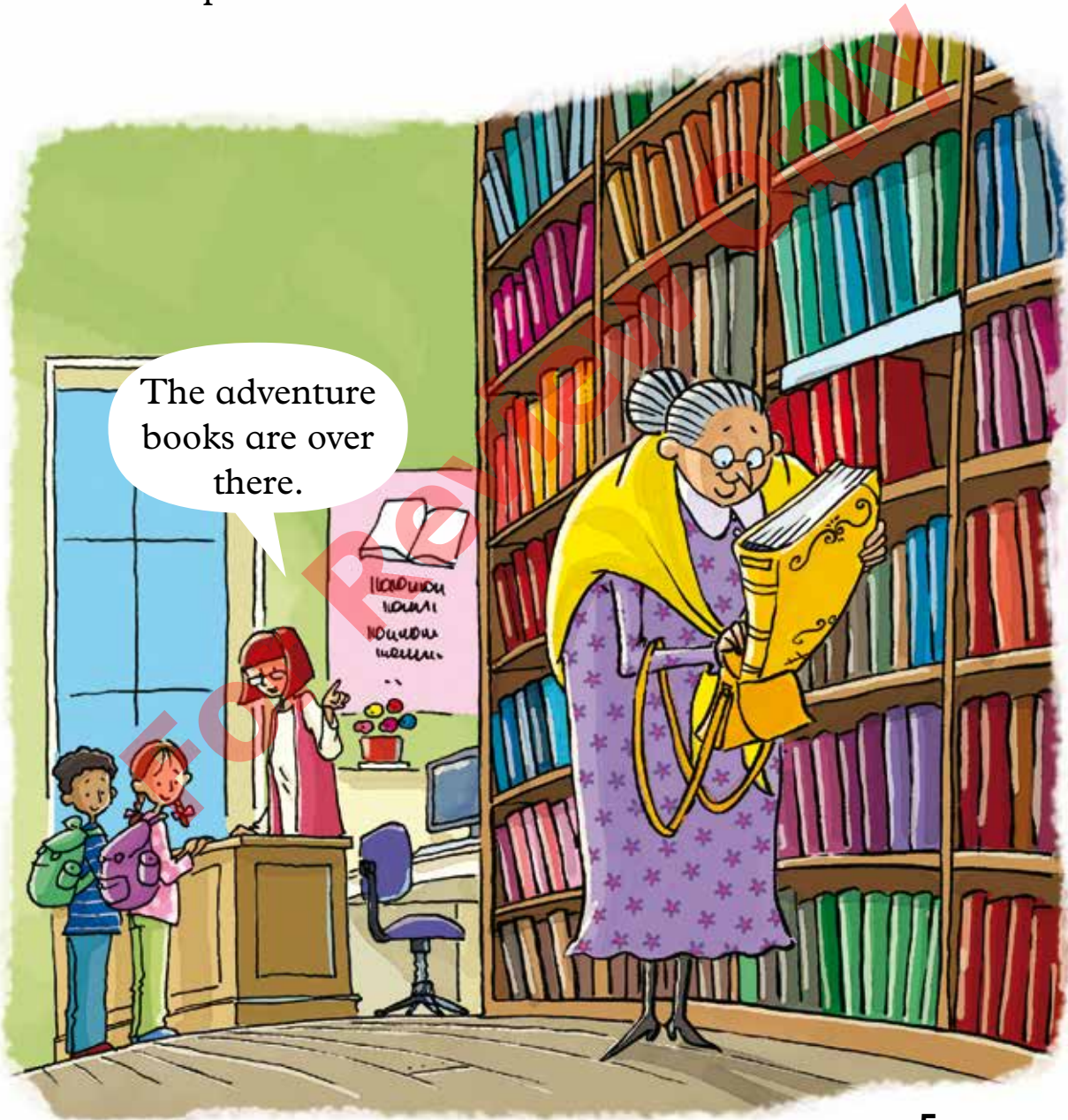
Ahmed and Jill are walking to the library.

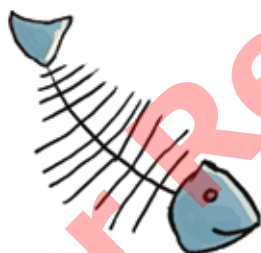

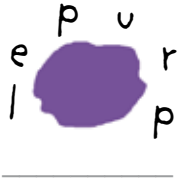
