NARRATOR This is the story of Little Red Riding Hood.

LRRH [*arrives and waves*] Hello! My name's Little Red Riding Hood. Do you like my red coat and red hood?

CAST [*all sing together*] Red, red! I love red!
I am Little Red Riding Hood.
Green like the grass
Blue like the sky
Yellow like the sun.
But red, red! I love red!
I am Little Red Riding Hood.

NARRATOR One day mummy calls Little Red Riding Hood.

MUMMY Little Red Riding Hood!

LRRH [*enters on stage*] Yes, mummy.

MUMMY Grandma isn't well. Take her this cake.

NARRATOR Mummy gives Little Red Riding Hood a basket.

MUMMY [*putting the food in the basket*] There is a cake.
There are biscuits. There are apples. There is some milk. Oh, and remember. Don't stop in the woods.
