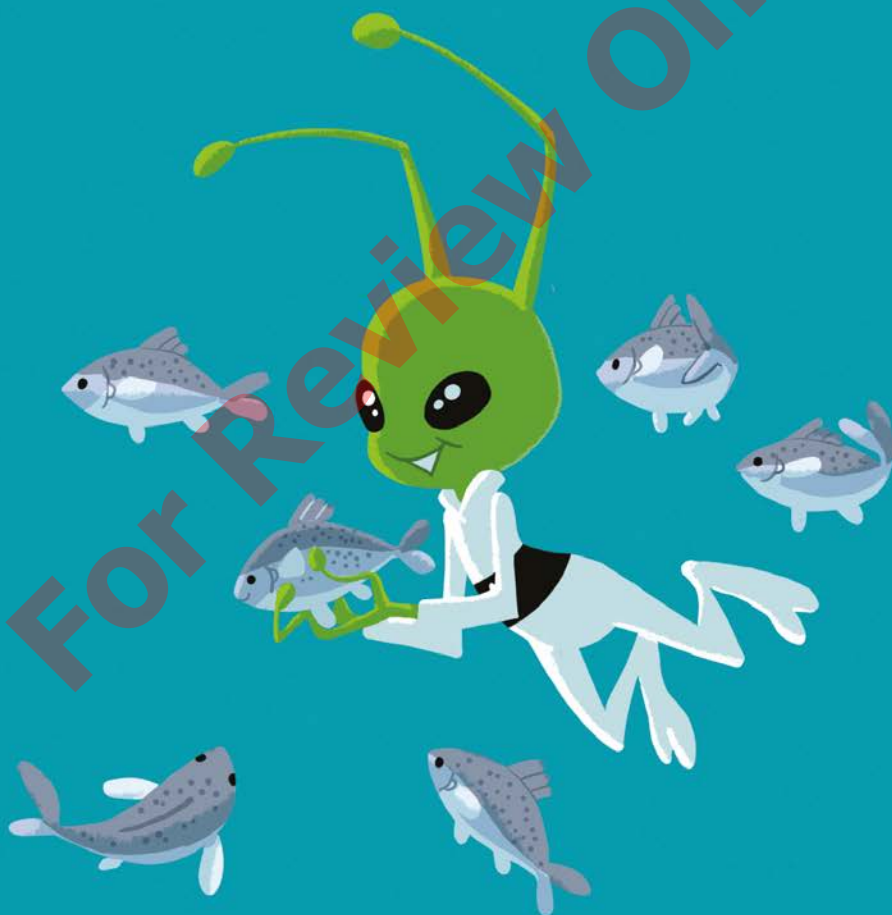

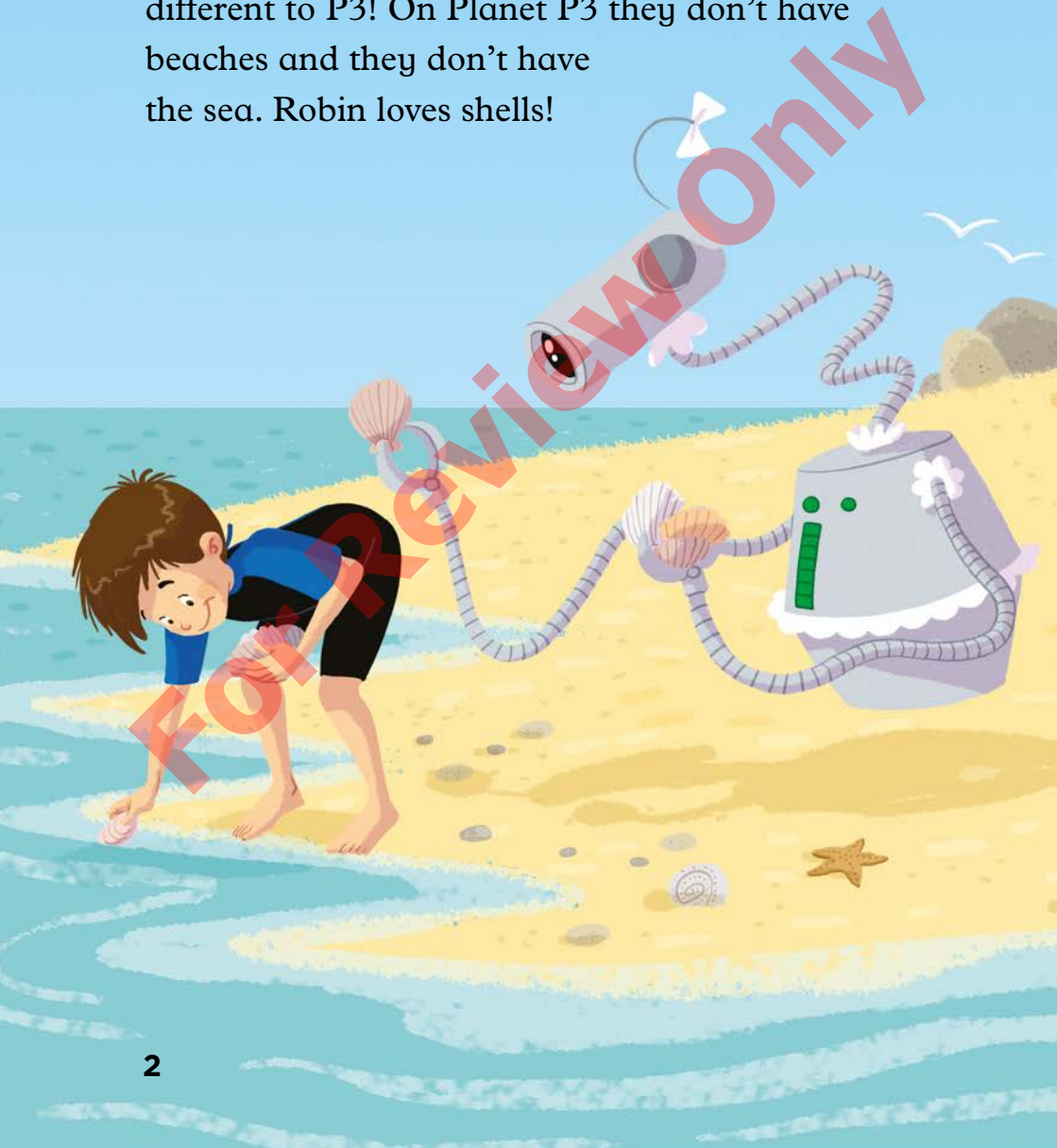
PB3 and the Fish

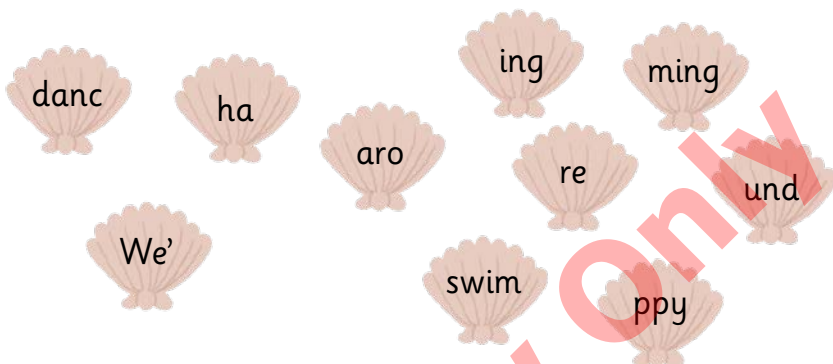

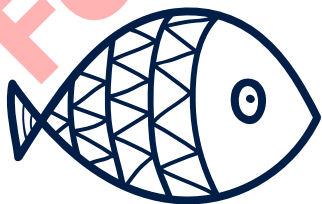

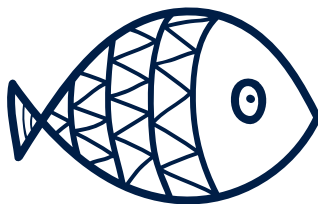
