Deep under the ground. It was a very deep hole.





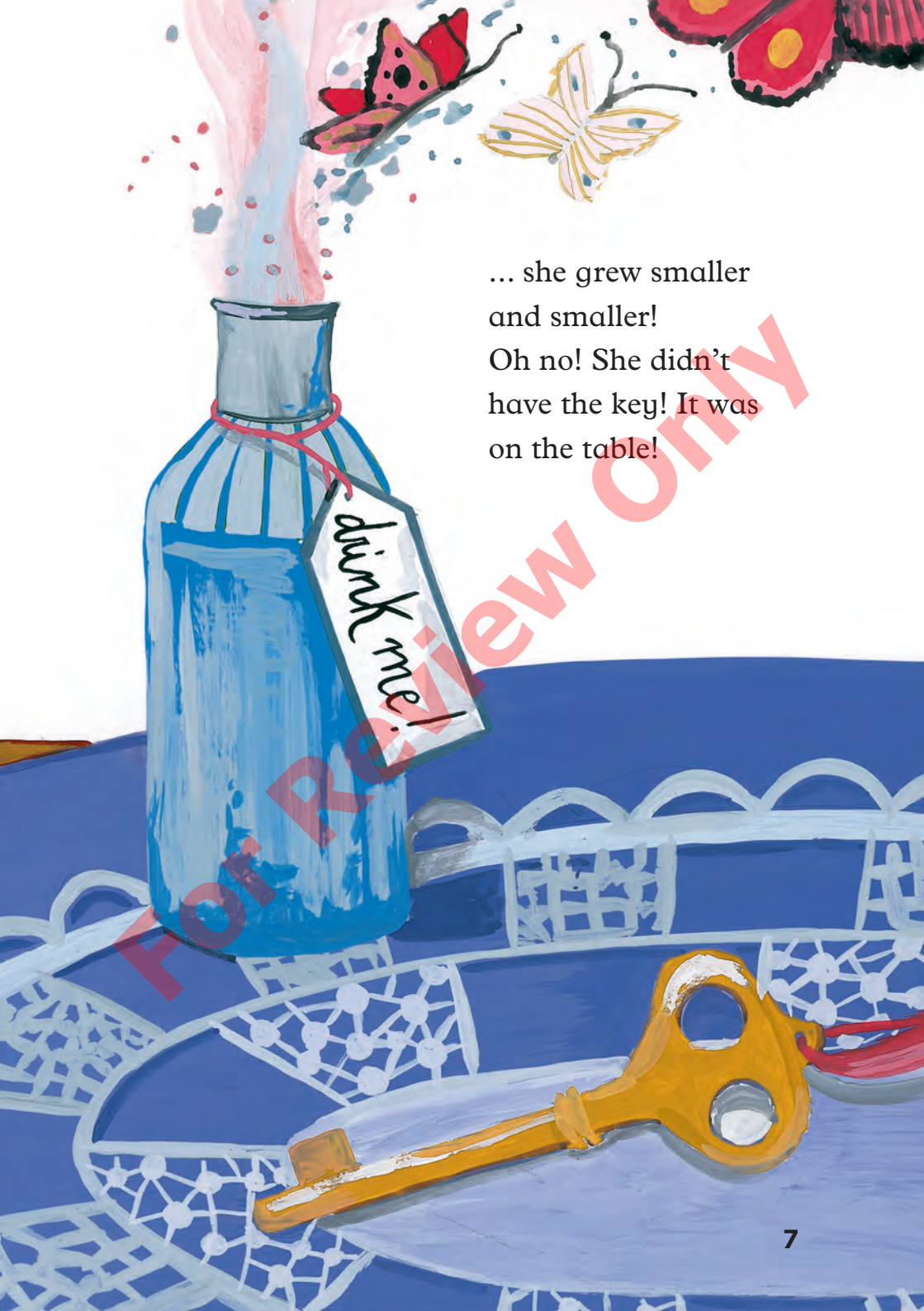
Alice fell, and fell, and fell.
