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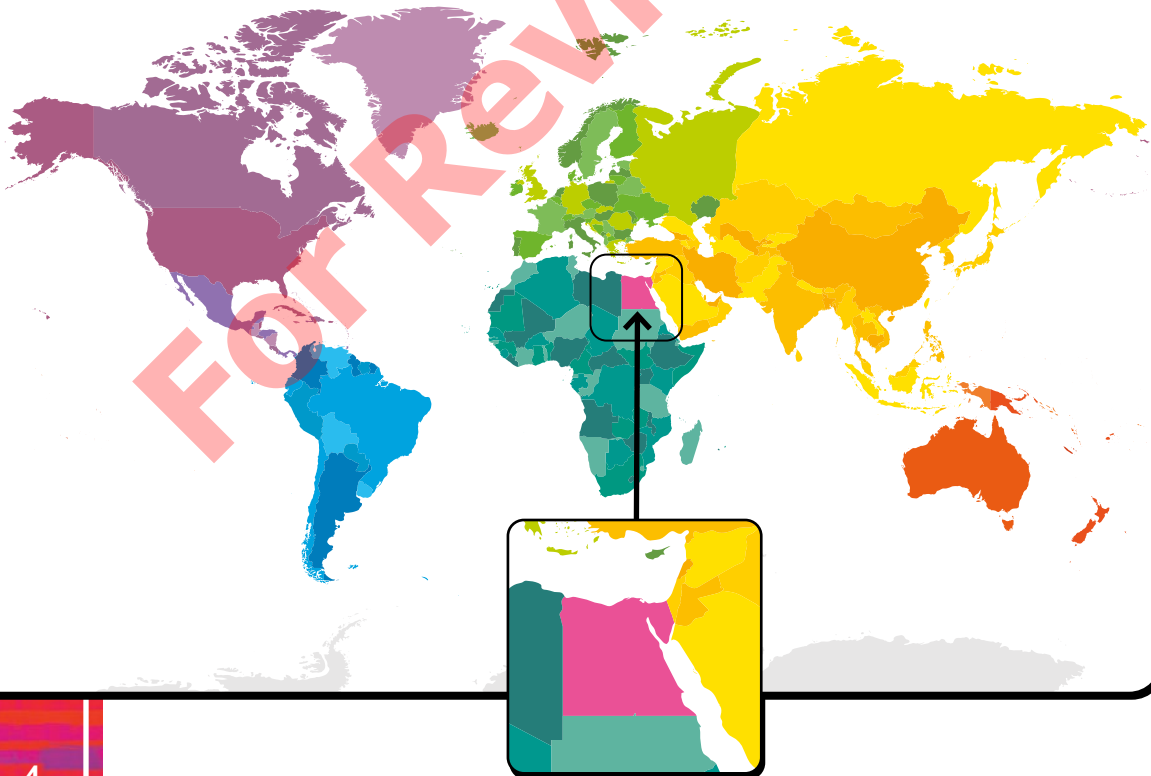

WELCOME TO EGYPT

Egypt is a country in northeastern Africa. It is known for the Nile River, museums, **ancient** pyramids, and more. Three pyramids make up the Pyramids of Giza.

People have lived in Egypt for 400,000 years. Today, more than 111 million people live in Egypt. Let's learn what life is like for kids in Egypt.

AT HOME

Families in Egypt live in many different types of homes. Most people live in apartments in large cities. Some families live in houses. Most of the population is along the Nile River. It flows all the way from the country's southern border to the Mediterranean Sea in the north.





Kids usually live with their parents and siblings. They may also live with grandparents. Sometimes they live with or near aunts, uncles, and cousins too.

TRAVEL AND SCHOOL

Most kids take the bus to school in Egypt. A family member might also bring them. School is usually Saturday through Thursday. Friday is a day of rest. School days are six hours long.

Some kids go to public school. Others go to private school. At school, they learn math, social studies, science, and more. Kids also learn about their religion.
