They are in the deep, dark woods.





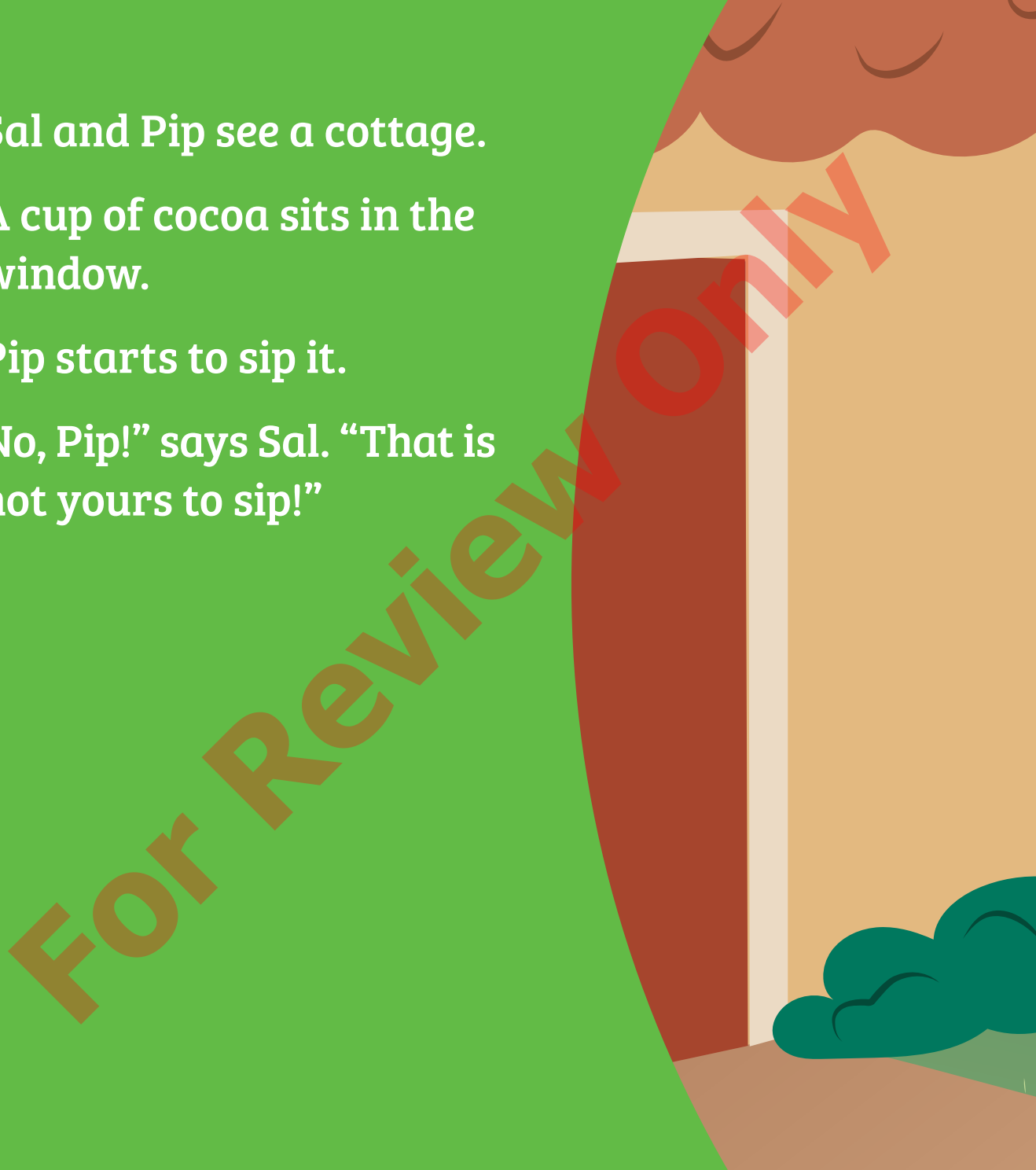
“Let’s go this way, Pip!” says Sal.
