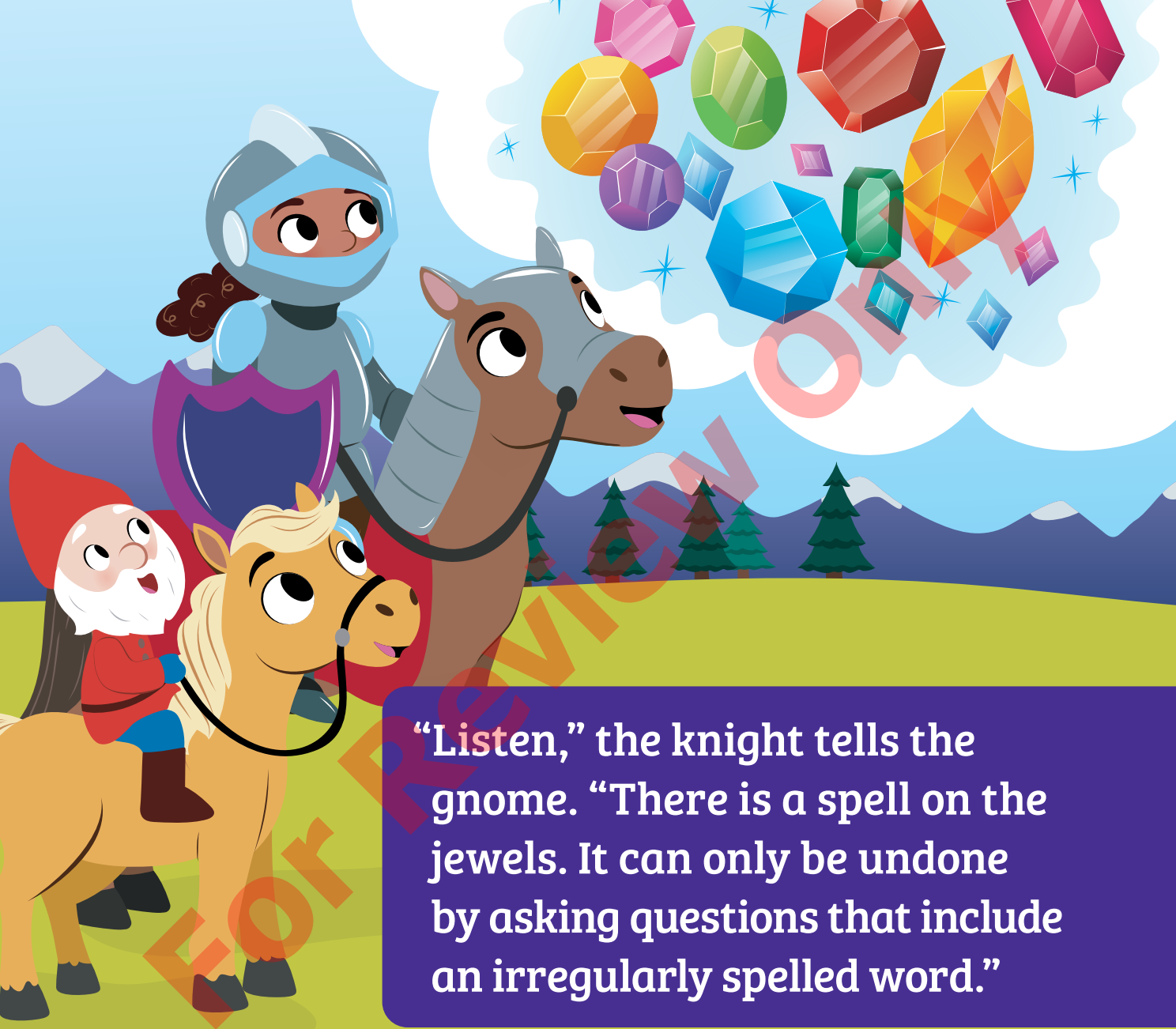
In This Book:
