



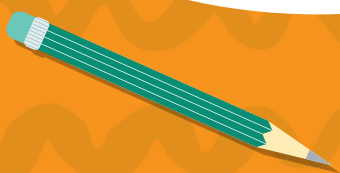

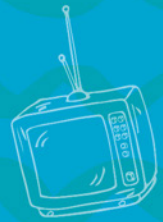


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How Things Are Made

There are many steps to creating these forms of entertainment. How are cartoons and anime made?

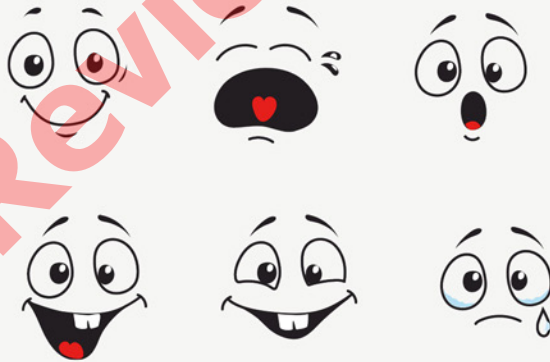


Cartoons vs. Anime

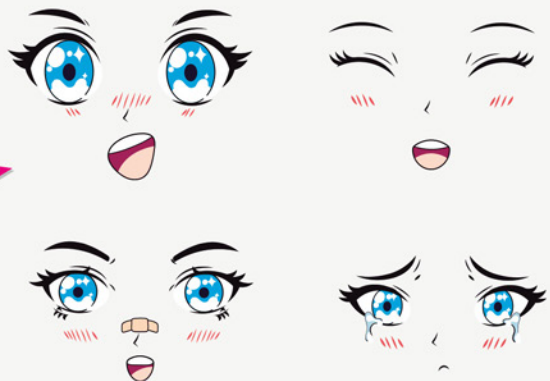


Cartoons and anime have slightly different art styles. Many cartoon characters are not very lifelike. They may look silly.

Anime faces

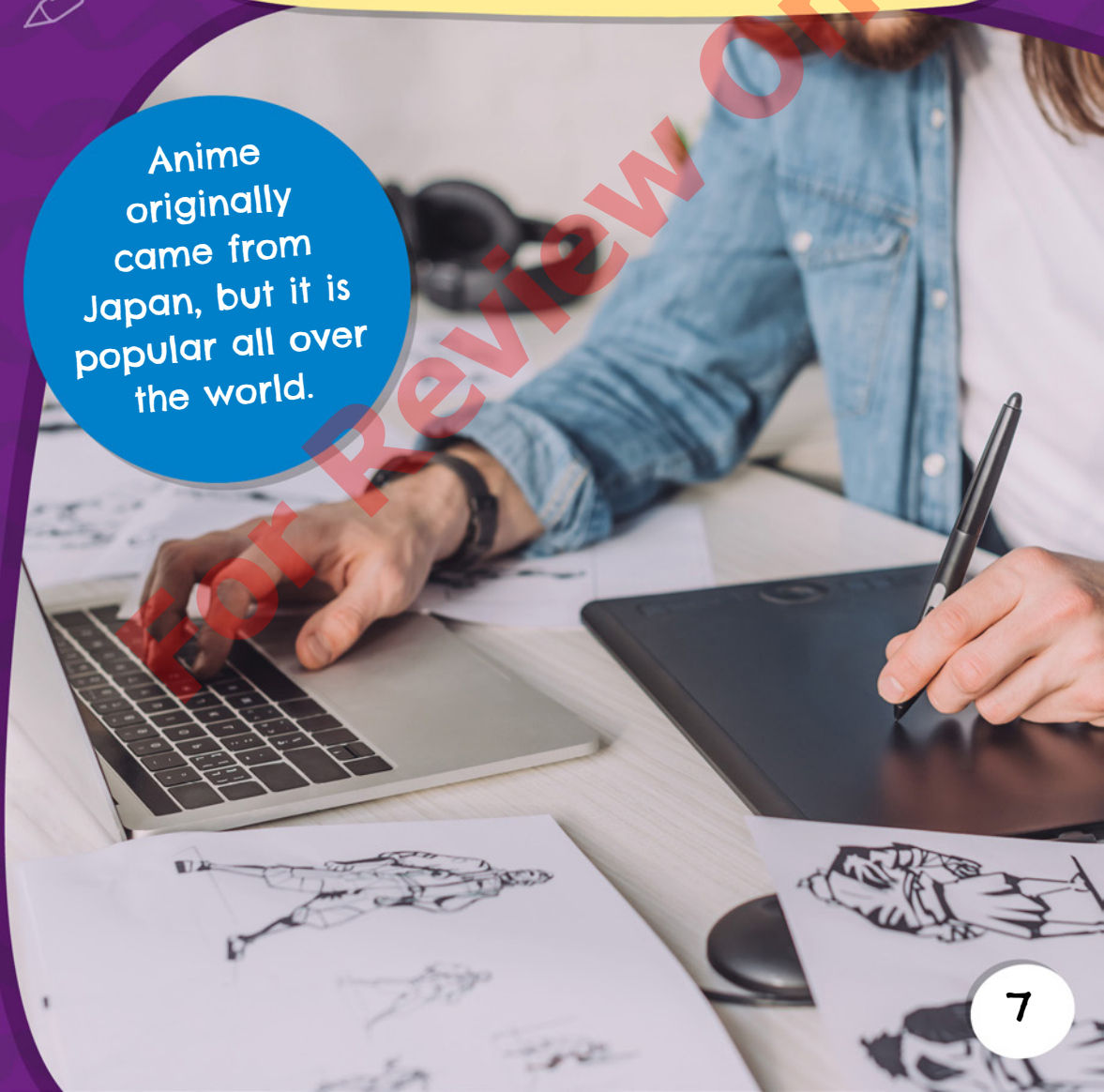


On the other hand, anime is more realistic. Its characters often have big eyes and colorful hair.
