

THE ENGLISH FUN DAY



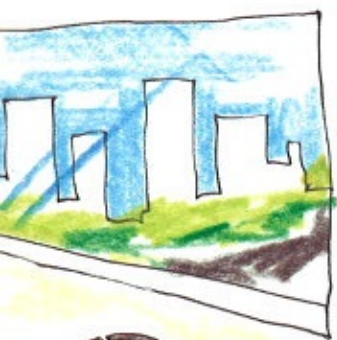

Today is the English Fun day. Everyone is very happy. Katie loves it because she likes playing games. Charlie loves it because he likes reading books.



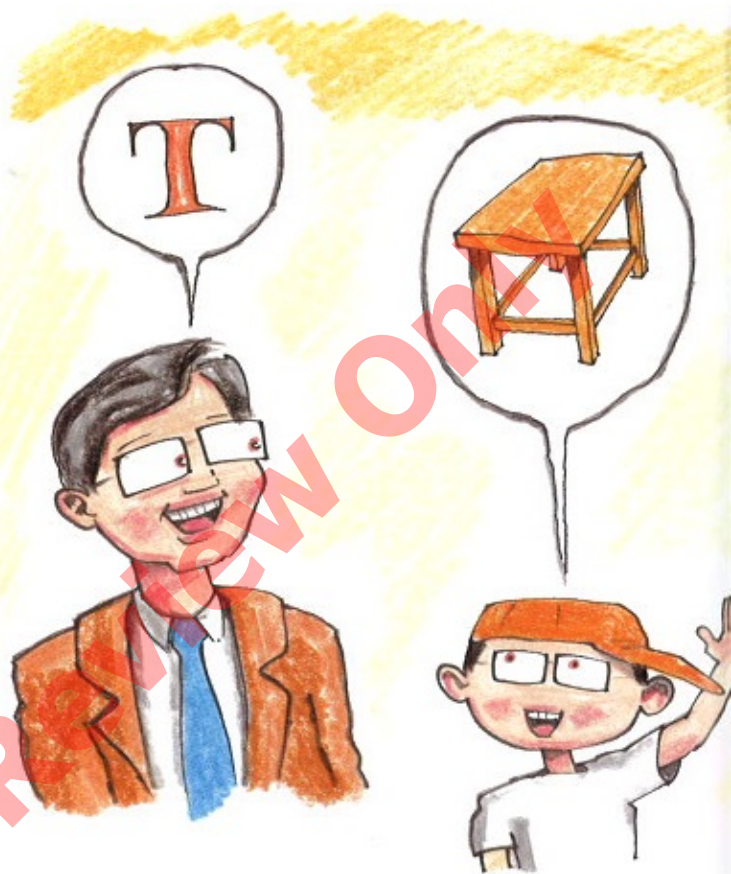
Everyone likes the English Fun Day because they like to do something different at school.
