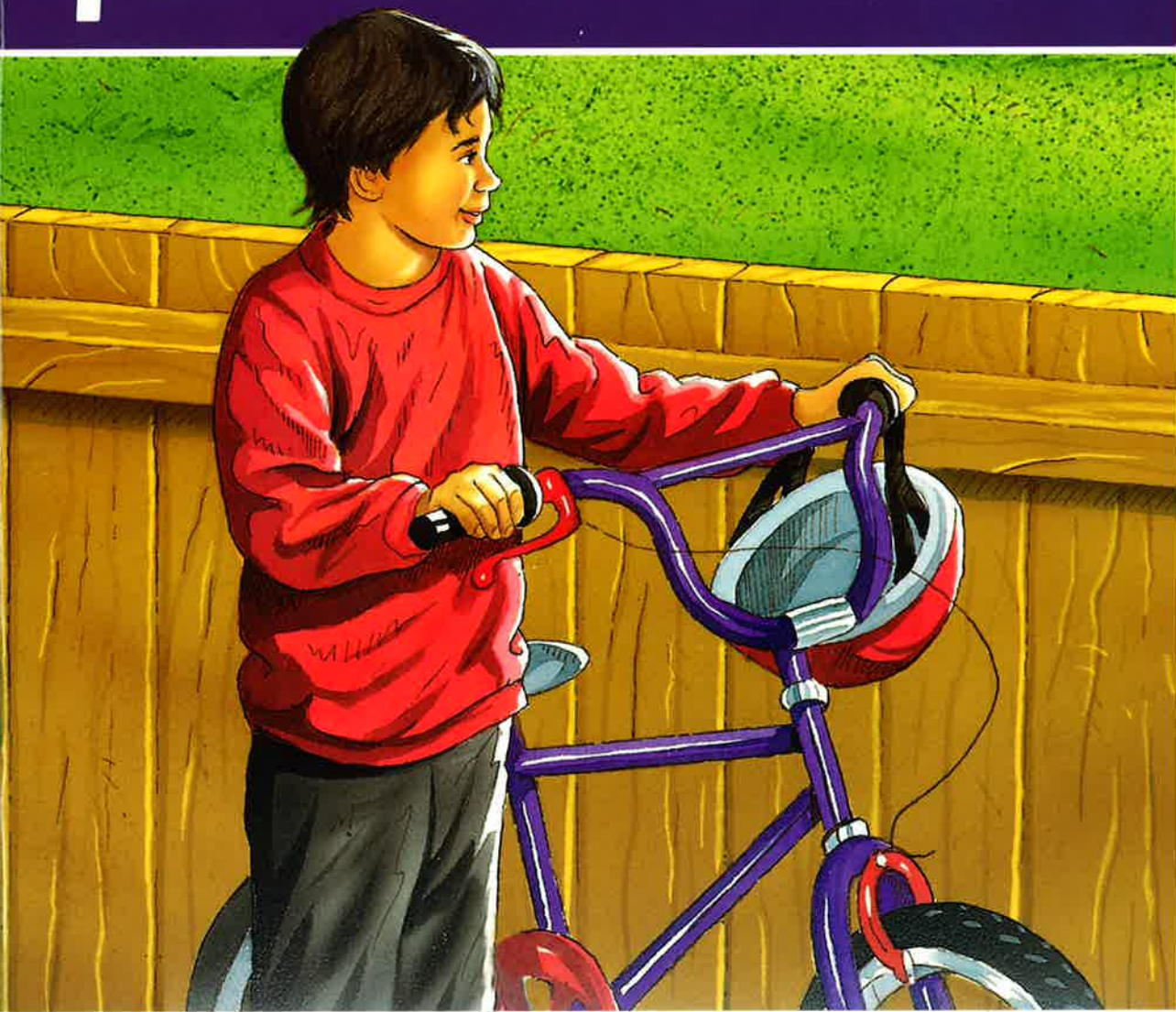


A Surprise for Zac

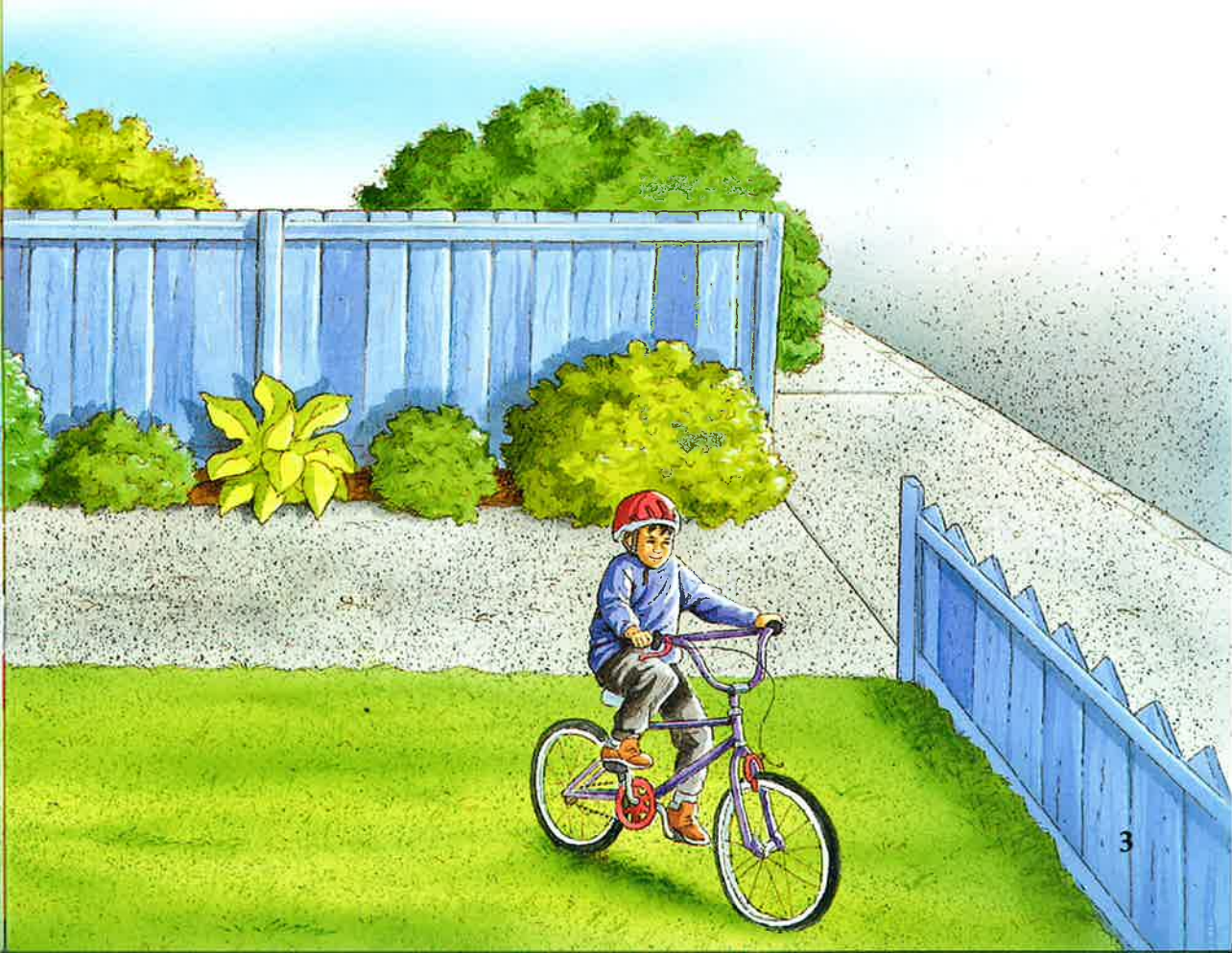
Zac was having one last ride

inspection ONLY



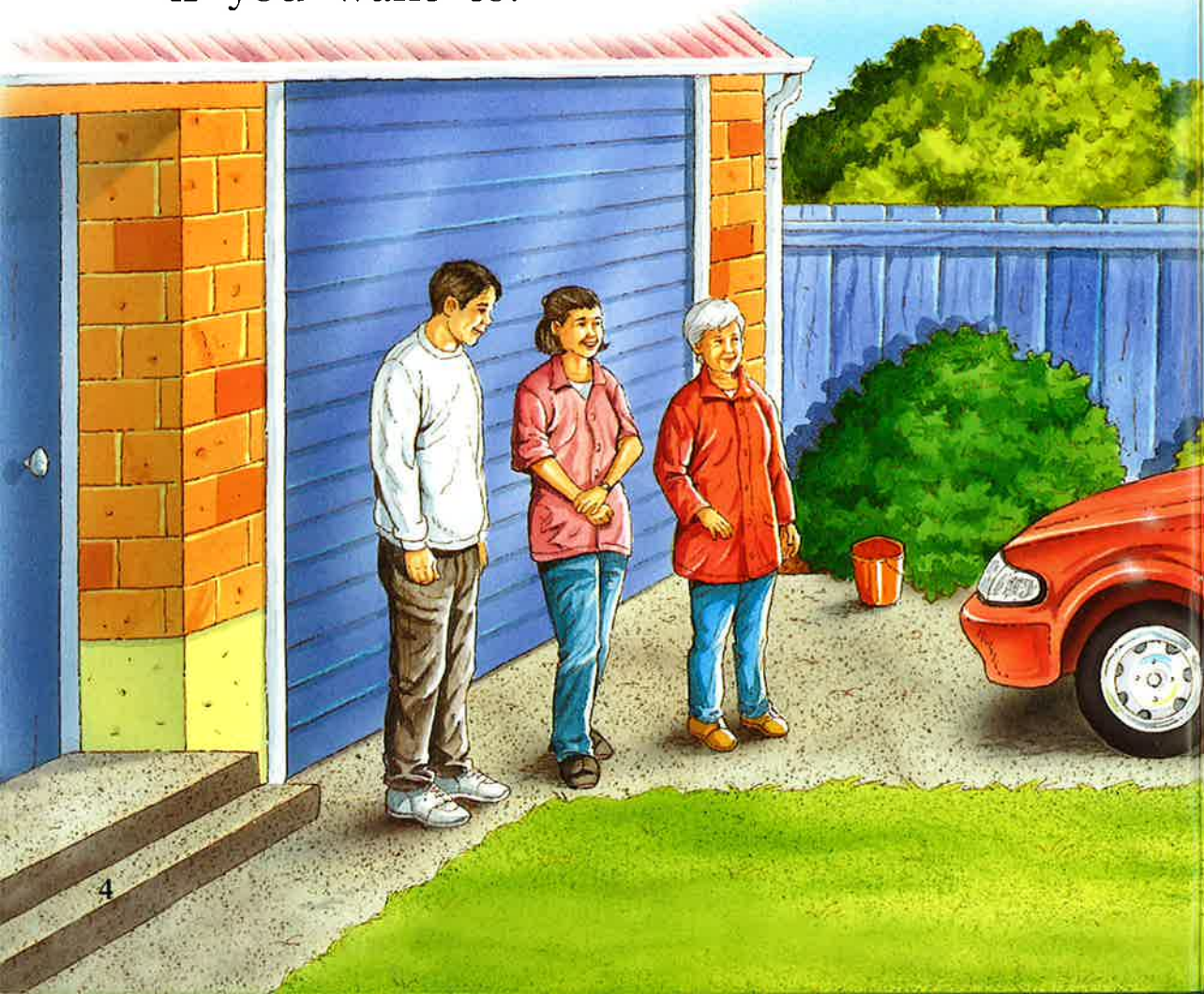
Zac couldn't take his bike with him.

if you want to.”

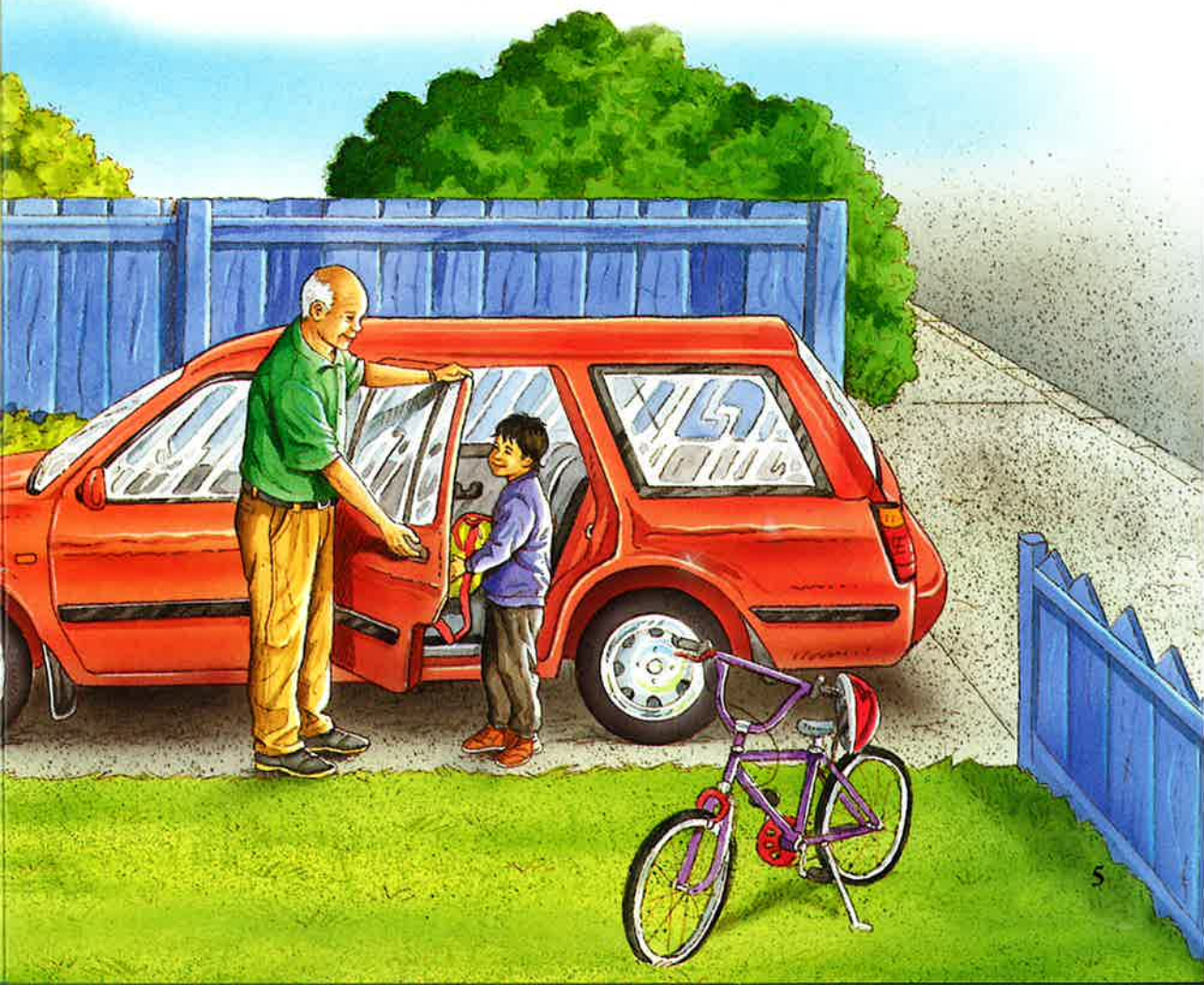


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“But Dad said there’s nowhere
