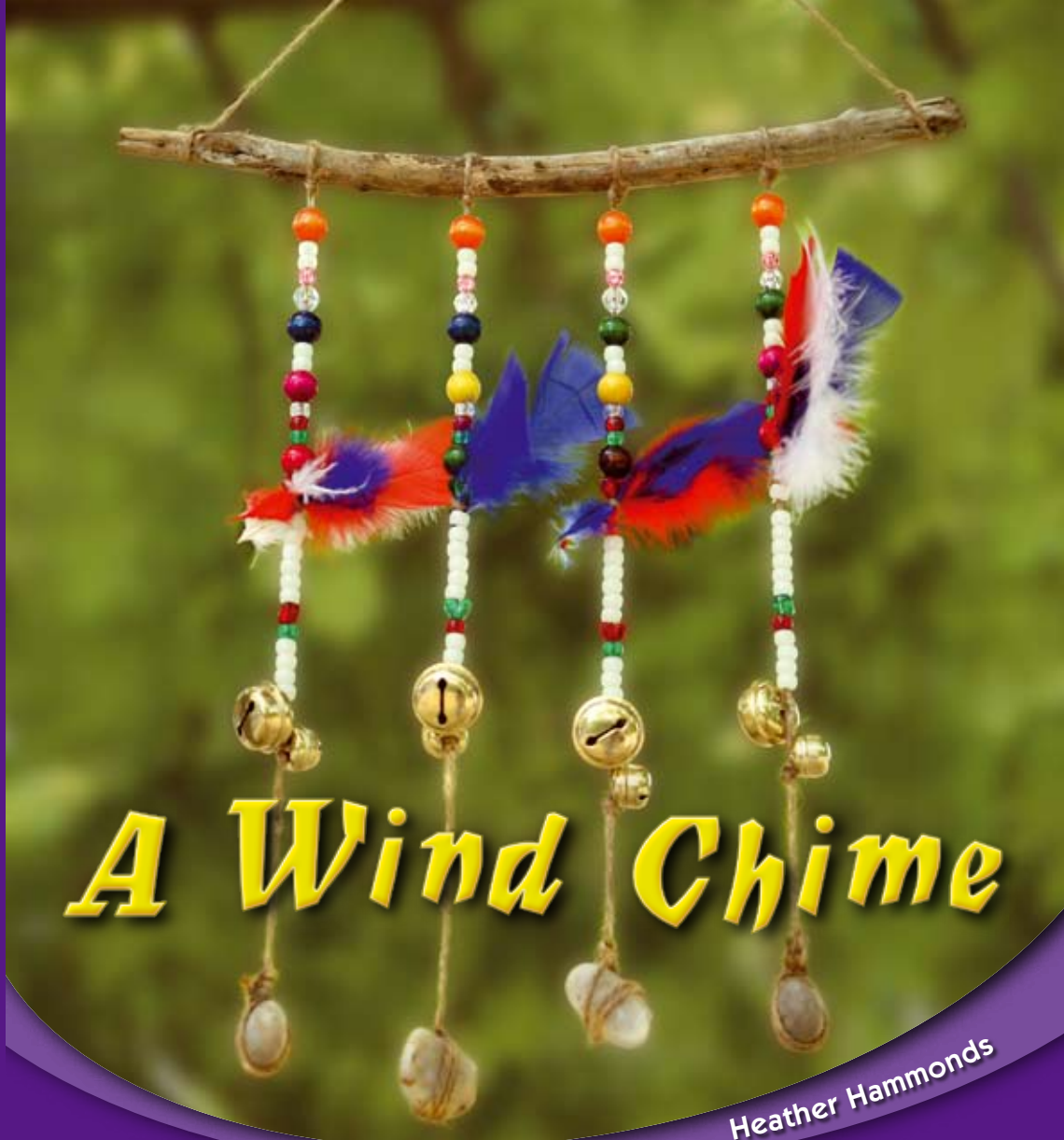

Text Structure

Introduction: Informs the reader about the subject being described (*Pages 2–3*)

Characteristics: Describes details about the subject (*Pages 4–15*)

Evaluation: Provides a personal comment about the subject (*Page 16*)

Language Features

- Common nouns (*e.g. beads, feathers, string*)
- Pronouns (*e.g. it, some*)
- Adjectives (*e.g. long, windy*)
- Present tense verbs (*e.g. is, are, has*)
