



## Trusted reading practice program goes digital

SRA Reading Laboratory™ 2.0 is an interactive, personalized reading practice program based on the classic SRA Reading Laboratory print program. SRA Reading Laboratory™ 2.0 is built on the Common Core State Standards and features innovative 21<sup>st</sup> century digital and social skills.

## Accessing Complex Text

Each student's skill level is matched to a 50-point Lexile® level range and interest. Students not only have access to their 50-point Lexile® level but the 50-point Lexile® level above to expose them to complex text. As reading levels gradually increase in complexity, the selections gradually increase in word count to keep students challenged as they progress through the program.



## Pretest and Interest Inventory

Students begin the program with a pretest to determine the appropriate starting Lexile® level. After the pretest, students complete an interest inventory that will help the system highlight passages that align with each student's interests.

## Independent Reading Practice

After completing the pretest and interest inventory, students proceed to their homepage, which contains all the high-interest fiction and nonfiction readings in their 50-point Lexile® range.

The homepage shows an image for each passage and indicates additional information including:

- Point Value
- Number of "secrets"
- Student progress
- Number of students having completed the passage and their review
- Title of Passage

Before students start reading the passage they preview background information and thought-provoking questions about the passage.



# Enrich students' reading experience with motivating tools and resources

## Built-in Motivation

Within each passage, students earn points for unlocking "secrets" designed to encourage deeper understanding of the passage with challenging vocabulary, background information, or extension of subject knowledge. Student engagement is enhanced by the freedom of choice and the variety of passage types, in addition to the community, reward, and game features.

Throughout the passages, students can:





- Increase or decrease text size
- Highlight words, sentences, or paragraphs
- Access definitions of words
- Take notes

## Writing

Writing activities for each passage help students use critical thinking skills and text evidence. These activities can be turned on or off by the teacher.

## Fluency

Students encounter a fluency assessment after every fifth completed reading.





## Passage Review Summary

Students wrap up the passage with a summary of their scores on the reading and the activities. Students can rate and review the passage and share their thoughts with the community before moving on to the next reading.

## Enhance specific skills and challenge students at all levels

### Comprehension

Multi-level text dependent comprehension questions test students' understanding after each passage.



### Skill Building

Skill building exercises provide reinforcement in vocabulary, phonics, grammar, and word-study for each passage.

### Skill Tutorials


If students receive 85% or below on any one skill three times they will automatically receive a skill tutorial to help them better understand that skill. Each tutorial is followed by questions to further assess the students' knowledge on that skill. Teachers can also assign a skill tutorial at any time.

## Community Page

The Community page is the key to interactive elements like activity feeds and rewards. From this section, students can see what other students in their class, district, or the Reading Labs World are doing in the program as they track their own progress.

## My Work


The My Work page provides students with access to their current and completed assignments, notes, and overall progress.

The class management section provides teachers:


- To Do list that tracks student assignments


